 that it is appointed for all Men once to die
 do make and ordain this my last will and
 testament. I do principally and first of all
 give my Soul to God who gave it and my
 Body to be buried in a decent manner and
 as touching my worldly estate that it hath
 pleased God to bless me with I give likewise
 and dispose of the same in the manner and
 form following, first I give and bequeath to
 my beloved wife all that tract of Lands that
 I purchased from Mr. Banger and Mr. Living-
 stone lying in Otsego Town whereon I now
 live to have and to hold as long as she
 shall remain my widow and I give to Eli-
 zabeth my wife all and singular all my
 household goods that are to be used in my
 house to have and to hold as long as she
 shall remain my widow and if she shall
 marry to another Man I give to her one
 and Bedding also I give to my elder son Sa-
 vid Young the sum of sixteen for his both
 rights also I do give to my son in law
 hundred acres of Lands adjoining Schramb-
 ling which I give to him after my wives
 marriage or decease also the rest of my Lands
 that I have I give all and singular to
 my Sons John Young and David Young
 to have and to hold forever also I will that

86 That John Winn Esq! shall by an
 agreement made between him and me
 pay Mr Banyer and Mr Luningstone for
 this six hundred acres of Land that I pur-
 chased of them here in Wags Town and
 what is not done then my executors
 may sell my Land that I have in
 Montgomery County or as much of them
 as will pay for these Lands here in Wags
 Town and if it may be after my Land here
 is paid for and then shall remain any
 Land or money I will that it be divided
 between my Sons David and John and
 Jacob I will that my Horses and Cattle
 be kept together on the farm with
 Elisabeth my wife also my farming tools
 to be kept together on the farm as long as
 Elisabeth my wife shall remain my wife
 or if my wife and sons John and Jacob
 shall agree to divide Horses and Cattle then
 they can I will that John and Jacob
 shall have the one of my farming tools
 as well as my wife I will that my son
 David shall make a plow and a half one
 half of a wheel Plow and a Suffolk Sley
 one half and I do make and ordain
 Jacob Wolf of Harper Town to be execu-
 tor of this my last will and Testament
 and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke
 and disannul all and every other
 former Testaments wills legacies be-
 quests and executors by me in any
 wise before named willed and bequeath.
