nominated and appointed And as for and concerning
my worldly things as itt shall please god to bestow
upon me I give and bequeath the same as followeth
Item I give unto my Son James Bradshaw the sum
of some pounds of lawfull money of great Brittain
due to mee upon bond from Margrett Bridge of Burton
wood and all interest now due or to become due for the
same and also the two pieces now in the hands
of William Etherland of Burtonwood aforesaid and

which doo now belong to me IEM I give unto my
son in law John Rigby of Burthwood aforesaid
the sum of ten pounds of like lawfull money where
sum is now due to me by bond from Joshua Leigh of
Warrington in the said County and all interest due and
to become due for the same and also I give unto him
the other ten now in the hands of the said William
Lithorland IEM I give and bequeath unto Margrett
Bradshaw daughter of my son Thomas Bradshaw
the sum of five pounds of lawfull ^{money} Brittain which
is due to me by bond from John Dowdall of Redbenik
^{near Warrington} in the said County and also all interest due or to become
due for the same IEM I give and bequeath unto
my son John Bradshaw the Treasurer now in my
Custody called York and Bridd and also two of my

Mares called Brock and muffs and the goods to them
belonging and all my carts wheels ploughs harrow
Saddles Bridles and halfers and all other my husbandry
implements whatsoever to be sold and separate up
And as for and concerning all the rest residue and remainder
of my goods chattels and chattels it is my will and I doe
heroby give and bequeath of the same unto my said son
John Bradshaw ^{and wife} Ann Bradshaw Elizabeth Bradshaw and
Miss Glover now wife of Peter Glover of Sutton aforesaid
to be equally divided amongst them the said John Bradshaw
Ann Bradshaw Elizabeth Bradshaw and Miss Glover
share and share ^{alike} by my last will hereafter named And lastly
I doe hereby nominate and appoint my said son John
Bradshaw John Case of Sutton aforesaid gentleman and
James Fenion of Sutton aforesaid Ironmonger Executors
of this my last will hoping they will be the same
performed as my trust is in them In witness whereof I the
said Thomas Bradshaw have hereunto putt my hand this
twentieth day of August In the Eight year of the reign of
Queen Ann our great Brittain &c and in the year of our
lord god 1709
