PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

In the matter of the petition of Mrs Dora Rieth ^{2nd Judicial District Court of Montana} to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.

To the 2nd Judicial District Court of Montana

The petitioner of Mrs Dora Rieth respectfully shews:

First. My full name is Mrs Dora Rieth

Second. My place of residence is number 1505 So. Bayland street, Butte city of Montana State of Montana

Third. My occupation is Housewife

Fourth. I was born on the 27 day of May, anno Domini 1851, at Saxon, Germany

Fifth. I emigrated to the United States from Saxon, Germany on or about the 24th day of June, anno Domini 1869, and arrived at the port of New York in the United States, on the vessel Hanza

Sixth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 5th day of January, anno Domini 1904 at Butte Montana in the 2nd Judicial District Court of Montana

Seventh. I am single and now reside at Butte Montana I have 4 children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

- Ellen Rieth, 24th day of October 1872, Portland Ore, now resides in Portland Ore
- Will Rieth, 6th day of March 1877, Portland Ore, now resides in Butte Mont
- Agnes Rieth, 6th day of October 1881, Portland Ore, now resides in Butte Mont
- Frank Rieth, 27th day of April 1885, Portland Ore, now resides in Butte Mont

Eighth. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to William II Emperor of Germany of which at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Ninth. I am able to speak the English language.

Tenth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for a term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 4th day of July, anno Domini 1869, and in the territory of Montana for one year at least next preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 13th day of May, anno Domini 1890

Eleventh. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. I made petition for citizenship to the Court of Butte Montana on the 5th day of January, anno Domini 1904 and the same was dismissed by the court on the following grounds: to wit, that the petitioner was not a resident of the United States at the time she made said petition.

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Commerce and Labor required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that she may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
