To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Jonas Mann of Brown County Ohio*  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Terre Haute, State of Indiana*  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Jonas Mann*  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
*The North East quarter of section three, and Township eighteen, north, of Range five, west, in the District of*  
*Covington and State of Indiana, containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and eighty hundredths*  
*of an acre*  
according to the official plot of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Jonas Mann*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Jonas Mann*  
the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Jonas Mann*  
and his heirs and assigns, forever.

**PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington, the *fourth* day of *July* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty *three*, and of the Independence of the United States the *forty seven*th.
