To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Jonas Mann* of *Drown County, Ohio* has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Terre Haute, State of Indiana* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Jonas Mann* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the North East quarter of Section Thirty three, in Township Twelve North, of Range Five West, in the District of *Terre Haute and State of Indiana*, containing Eighty acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Jonas Mann*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Jonas Mann* and to his heirs the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *Jonas Mann* and his heirs and assigns forever.
