From here all the information I have according to the family group record is Cornelius Outland Born 2 Nov 1745 was father to, Axum Outland Born 28 Feb 1778 who was father to Josiah (Joseph) Peele Outland Born 6 March 1800 who was father to Cornelius Outland II Born 23 October 1828 who was father to Levi Addison Outland Born 30 June 1852 who was father to my Grandfather Fernando Claude Outland Born 21 August 1879. I do not have anything showing dates for the marriage, death, or children for Josiah Born 1800, Axum Born 1778, Cornelius Born 1745.

It reads also about how Cornelius Outland and William Wood were talking about the area and how it is growing, and that it needs a name so they took Wood the last name of William, and took Land from the last name of Outland, and now it's called Woodland, N.C.

There is not much information on Axum, William or Thomas in Ancestry.com but from my information on my family tree it tells me that Thomas Born 8 September 1785 may not be Cornelius Born 1829's father.
