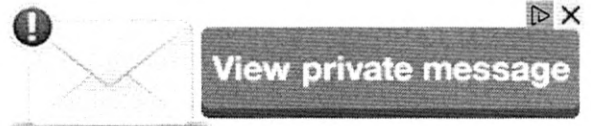

JEREMIAH "Judge" EXUM

Referred to as "Judge" Exum. He made his will on 3 September 1712, and it was recorded 28 March 1720.

In his will he names daughter Elizabeth; daughter Mourning ; daughter Christian, the land I bought of James Collins; granddaughter Catherine Scott; my cousin Jane Exum; daughter Sarah; daughter Mary; daughter Jane; wife. Witnessed by John Gibbs, Thomas Godwin, Jr., Mary Godwin.

Jeremiah was one of the Justices of the County Court of Isle of Wight in 1693-94[CI:368:73:CI]. Occupation-Justice-Isle of Wight County, Virginia

Jeremiah Exum, of Isle of Wight County , will of. Dated Sept. 3, 1712; to daughter Elizabeth, one negro girl called Patty, one feather bed, rugg, blankett and sheets; to his daughter Mourning, one negro boy called Harry one feather bed ,

rugg, blanketts & sheets; to his daughter Christian, on e negro girl called Doll, one feather bed, rugg, blanket t & sheets, also the parcell of land which testator bough t of James Collins; to his granddaughter Catherine Scott, o ne negro boy called Skipper; to his cousin Jane Exum, one c ow and calf; Lends to his wife during her natural life th e plantation whereon the testator lives and after his deat h to go to his daughters Elizabeth and Mourning; to his wif e 3 negroes, Bess, Sarah & Joe outright, lends to his wif e during her natural life the rest of his negroes and to hi s daughters, Sarah, Mary, Eliza, Jane, Mourning & Christia , the negroes and personal estate loaned his wife during he r natural life. Executrix, his wife. Wit: John Gibbs, Thos . Godwin, Jr., Mary Godwin.

At a court held for Isle of Wight County, Virginia the 28t h of March 1720, the last will and Testament of Jeri. Exu m was presented by the Executrix who made solemn affirmatio n and proved by the oaths of Thos. Godwin and John Gibbs Wi tnesses & admitted to record. Bk. 2, p. 21.

Jeremiah Exum. "The difference depending between Jeremiah E xum & Isaac Rickes, Sr., is finnally ended upon this provis or Isaac Rickes, Jr., and Robert Rickes, his brother hath e ach of them alike passed the obligation for two thousand po unds of Tobacco to the widow namely Mary Rickes, the wido w of Jacob Rickes dec'd which is done in lieu of his childr ens part or portion of land or anything else which may be c laimed after the decease of the said Isaac Rickes, Sr." 1 4 day 7 month 1704.

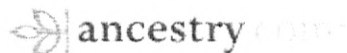
