WILLIAM BUNDY

1. William\super1\nosupersub Bundy was born in England, ab t 1630. William died 27 Mar 1692 in Perquimans County, North Carolina, at 61 years of age.

He married twice. He married Elizabeth ?? in RI (prob.), 1663. Elizabeth was born abt 1640 in England. Elizabeth die d 4 Mar 1675/76 in Perquimans County, North Carolina, at 35 years of age. He married Mary Scott in Perquimans County , North Carolina, 15 Dec 1683. Mary was born 1649. Mary die d 22 Mar 1723/24 in Pasquotank County, North Carolina, at 74 years of age. She was the widow Pierce at time of marriag e to William Bundy. The Bundy family is of French descent , originally spelling their name Bundeie. According to th e family tradition, their ancestors were among the French Huguenots driven out of France by the Catholic persecutions who settled in Wales. About the middle of the 17th century some of the more venturesome

sailed from Pembroke, Wales , for America. Members of the family residing in Worcesters hire in southwest England adopted as the family crest, a ha nd, holding an eagle's leg and had as their motto, Certum p ete finem." (Aim at a sure end.)

Coming probably from Worcestshire, England, to Massachusetts, William and wife Elizabeth appeared first in Rhode Islan d where they purchased 200 acres of land in 1663. In less t han six months they sold the land and William and Elizabet h were among the first emigrants from New England to Nort h Carolina.

The Bundys settled on plantations reaching out from both ba nks of Little River, that forms a natural boundary betwee n Pasquotank County and Perquimans County, NC. Albemarle Co unty was abolished in 1729 when each of the four precincts , Perquimans, Pasquotank, Curritack, and Chowan became a co unty.

William Bundy was a cordwainer by trade. He settled in Perq uimans Precinct but the date is unknown.

William Bundy was a member of the first Quaker organizatio n in Perquimans Precinct which met at the home of the membe rs. William's wife, Elizabeth, whom he probably married bef ore coming to Carolina, died March 4, 1676. Seven years lat er at a quarterly meeting held at the home of Christopher N icholson, William Bundy and Mary Pearre, widow of John Pear re and daughter of Joseph Scott, published their intentio n of marriage. They were married at her home "Desember 15 , 1683."

William Bundy is recorded as being a witness at several wed dings in 1680. His signature appeared on a remonstrance dat ed September 25, 1679, which was addressed to the Duke of A lbemarie by the Quakers, most of whom had been inhabitant s of Carolina since 1663. The court records show that he as signed to Mary Scott all his interests to an Indian named S anders, April 6, 1680. He served as one of the justices a t a court held for the Precinct of Perquimans at the home o f Mary Scott, the first Monday in January, 1690-1. In ever y precinct the court consisted of a judge and four justices . To be an eligible candidate for justice, a man must hav e been an inhabitant of the precinct and own 300 acres of l and. He is listed among the Quakers who were sentenced an d imprisoned for refusing to bear arms, serving a six month s' term in 1680.

6 v. Samuel Bundy was born in Perquimans County, North Carolina, 04 Feb 1675/76. Samuel died 14 Mar 1739/40 in Pasquotank County, North Carolina, at 64 years of age. He married twice. He married Tamar Symons in Pasquotank County, North Carolina, 05 Oct 1696. Tamar was born 04 Dec 1680 in Pasquotank County, North Carolina. Tamar died 17 Mar 1718/19 in Pasquotank County, North Carolina, at 38 years of age. He married Ann Nicholson in Perquimans County, North Carolina, 11 May 1721. Ann was born 08 Feb 1688/89 in Perquimans County, North Carolina. Ann died 16 Sep 1743 in Perquimans County, North Carolina, at 54 years of age. 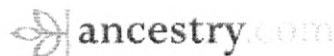
