Butts, Mown's Swamp, Silas Lassiter, Wm. Holliday conveyed to Thomas Holliday by Isaac Brand 16 April, 1814 which sd. tracts were devised to Lucy, the wife of Cladius B. Churchwell by her father Thos. Holliday and by Cladius Churchwell and wife and Jno. S. Hawks, trustee, sold to Wm. Williams 27 May, 1832.
