William Hunt, Alfred Upchurch, and James Vinson approved the account of the admr.

VICK, ACHSEY inventory and sale by William Burt, Dec. 4, 1813. Jacob Vick, Nathan Vick, and Elijah Vick were buyers.

VICK, ASAEL (ASAHHEL) inventory and sales by James B. H. Boddie, exr., Dec. 4 and 5, 1856. Large estate. The widow, B. S. Vick, W. R. Vick, and R. T. Vick were among the buyers. Inventory of notes due and property lent to the widow, E. W. Vick, in the will of the decd. Inventory of the property included eleven volumes of law books, one lot of religious, and one lot of school books. Account of hire of thirty-seven negroes, Dec. 4, 1856, Feb. Term 1857, twenty-eight by the widow.

VICK, BENJAMIN, JR. inventory by Archibald Griffin, exr., May 9, 1808.

VICK, BURTON A. inventory by Bennett Barnes, admr., Nov. 9, 1822, Feb. Term 1823 and again Aug. 10, 1823. Sale held Jan. 3, 1823. Sale of negroes, Feb. Term 1823. Account current, Nov. Term 1823. Account received from guardian of the decd.

VICK, ELI inventory by Josiah Vick, admr.. Nov. Term 1823. Post inventory taken Dec. 1, 1823. Account current in which year's allowance was paid to Elizabeth Vick. At May Term 1826, commissioners were appointed to settle the accounts between Athelston Anderson, admr. of Josiah Vick, and Elijah Vick, admr. D. B. N. of Eli Vick.

VICK, ELIJAH inventory by Jesse Beal, admr., Nov. 11, 1845. Sale held Dec. 29, 1845, with the widow, John R. Vick, James Odum, and Elias Barrett among the buyers. Jackey C. Barrett paid for keeping negro. Account current, May Term 1848. Year's allowance paid to widow and Elizabeth Vick mentioned.

VICK, ELIZABETH inventory by Timothy Terrell, exr., Feb. Term 1834, included eleven negroes. Sales held June 3, 1830 and July 27, 1830, with Asael Vick, William Vick, Elizabeth Vick, Jr., and Henry Vick buy-

ers. Account current 1831-1833, Nov. Term 1835. There were not enough assets to satisfy debts without selling legacies and so each recipient was billed for a proportionate part: James Walker, Bolen Walker, John C. Hines, H. A. Barnes, Lucy Tunstall, and Mary Ann Hines.

VICK, HENRY inventory by Alex. W. Hines, admr., May 17, 1810. Post inventory, Feb. Term 1811. Account current, Nov. Term 1814.

VICK, ISAAC inventory of notes and accounts due and of personal property taken by Granberry Vick, exr., May Term 1832. Sale held March 8, 1832. Charity Vick, Henry Vick, and Josiah Vick were buyers. Account current, Feb. Term 1834.

VICK, JOEL inventory by Sarah Vick, admr., Sept. 20, 1804, Nov. Term 1804. Sale held Nov. 29, 1804 by John Vick, admr., with Sarah Vick principal buyer. Account current with John Vick, admr., 1806.

* VICK, JOHN, JR. inventory by John Vick, Sr., Nov. 8, 1824. Sale held Feb. 28, 1824, Nov. Term 1824. Martha Vick bought. Account current, May Term 1827.

* VICK, JOHN, SR. inventory by Samuel W. W. Vick, exr., Dec. 9 and 10, 1831. Inventory of the many notes due, May Term 1834. Sales held Dec. 6 and 7, 1831 and Jan. 5, 1832. The widow, Elizabeth Vick, Asail Vick, Elijah Vick, Martha Vick, William Vick, Samuel W. W. Vick, and Priscilla Whitfield were among the buyers. Accounts current, Feb. Term 1834 and May Term 1834. Son, William Vick, was a minor.

VICK, JOHN sale of property which was given to him by his father, Isaac Vick, held by Granberry Vick, exr. of Isaac Vick, decd., June 6, 1832. Charity Vick bought the bed and Granberry Vick the horse.

VICK, JOHN inventory by Josiah Vick and Granberry Vick, exrs., Aug. 1834, May Term 1838. Sale of property lent to his widow, Susanna Vick, which was on hand at the time of her death was held April 21, 1842 by Josiah Vick and Granberry Vick, exrs. to John Vick, whose will

was proved at Aug. Term 1834. Accounts current, May Term 1838 and May Term 1844.

VICK, JOHN H. inventory by Josiah Vick, exr., Sept. 29, 1859, Nov. Term 1859. Sale held same day, Nov. Term 1859. Property lent in his will to his mother, Mrs. Martha Vick, of which she retained some and sold the remainder, Sept. 29, 1859. Account current, Nov. Term 1859.

VICK, JOSEPH sale by Sam Westray, exr., June 8, 1816. Samuel Vick bought the saddlebags and bearskin. Account current, Nov. Term 1818. Paid to Bennet Barnes the balance of his wife's portion. Paid to Lem. Barnes as guardian to Burton Vick.

VICK, JOSIAH inventory by Athelston Anderson, admr., April 10, 1826. Sale held Aug. 15, 1829 by Timothy Terrell, admr. D. B. N. Another sale held, Nov. Term 1831. Account current 1826-1835. Paid Mrs. Martha Vick her year's allowance in 1827.

VICK, JOSIAH inventory of notes and accounts due taken by B. H. Blount, admr., Feb. Term 1846, filled fifty-three pages. Also, inventory of property, very lengthy. Account of rent of lands, Dec. 3, 1846, and sale and hire of negroes. Eight negroes were sold and ninety hired out. Account current 1845-1849, Nov. Term 1849.

VICK, LEWIS inventory by James Williams and Jacob Vick, exrs., Aug. 1, 1801. Sale held Aug. 21, 1801, with Achsa Vick, Jacob Vick, and Elender Vick principal buyers. Account current, 1804.

VICK, MARY inventory by James Hunter, admr., June 8, 1833, Aug. Term 1833.

VICK, MARY H. sale by Elijah H. Morgan, admr., Dec. 19, 1853. Account current, Nov. 26, 1855.

VICK, NATHAN, SR. account current with Nathan Vick, Jr., admr. with the will annexed, Aug. Term 1837.

VICK, NATHAN inventory by James Odom, admr., Sept. 25, 1845. Sale held Oct. 2, 1845 and Nancy Vick

bought everything. Account current, Feb. Term 1846. Nancy Vick paid for year's provisions.

VICK, RICHARD sale by Mary Vick, admr., March 8, 1806, Aug. Term 1806. Account current, Feb. Term 1808.

VICK, ROBERT, SR. inventory by Jacob Vick, exr., Aug. 6, 1796, included 100 acres of land.

VICK, SAMUEL W. W. inventory by William T. Dortch, Feb. Term 1846, included several pages of notes and accounts due. Further inventory and sale, Jan. 1, 1847, May Term 1848. He owned twenty shares of stock in the Wilmington & Raleigh Railroad.

VICK, SUSANNA (SUSAN) inventory by Josiah Vick, exr., March 28, 1842, taken in the presence of David Taylor and Dempsey Winstead. Sale held April 21, 1842. Josiah Vick bought almost all. Sale of property lent to her for her lifetime by her husband, John Vick, decd., also held April 21, 1842 by his exrs., Josiah Vick and Granberry Vick. Account current, May Term 1844.

VICK, URIAS inventory and sale by A. B. Bains, admr., Dec. 8, 1859. Widow principal buyer and Brinkley Vick rented the lands.

VICK, WILLIAM R. inventory and sale by John E. Thorn, admr., Dec. 11, 1857, Feb. Term 1858. Sally A. Vick principal buyer. Account current and settlement, Feb. Term 1860.

VICK, WILSON inventory and sale by Sam Westray, admr., Dec. 2, 1794. Joshua Vick, Henry Vick, Nathan Vick, Benjamin Vick, Lewis Vick, Sophia Vick, and John Vick bought. Account current, Nov. 14, 1796.

VICKERS, SOLOMON account current with Jethro Bass, admr., Feb. Term 1804.

VIVERETT, THOMAS inventory by William Dew, admr., Dec. 1, 1793, included fourteen negroes. Sales held by Jesse Pitman, exr., Dec. 15, 1791, for the benefit of James Viverett, Lancelot Viverett, Henry

Viverett, and Michael admr. of Jesse Thomas Viverett.

WALKER, DAVID admr., Oct. 25, 1808. Account current, Nov. Term 1808.

WALKER, WILLIAM Thorn, admr., Dec. 1808. Frederick Walker. Account current, from Turner Walker.

WALL, JAMES Powell, exrs., April 1808. Book, three padlocks held same day. Prayer Book. Account current, 1783, mentioned Wall and Betsey V.

WARD, FRANCIS Ward, exrs., Nov. 1808. Account current.
