#431 p. 258 Allotment of dower to OLIFF MELTON, widow of JOHN MELTON, deceased, by jury, Dec. 22, 1826, a tract of 246 acres on the creek.

#432 p. 258 Division of the personal estate of JOHN MELTON, deceased, by jury, Jan. 4, 1827, in order that the widow, OLIFF MELTON, might receive her share.

#433 p. 259 Division of negroes into five lots by commissioners, May 20, 1822, so that WILLIAM HORN, one of the legatees, might receive his share. Returned to Nov. Term 1822.

* #434 p. 260 Allotment of dower to MARTHA VICK, widow of JOHN VICK, deceased, by jury, Aug. 3, 1825, a tract of 25 acres on the north side of Stony Creek adjoining ELIJAH VICK.

#435 p. 261 Allotment of dower to ELIZABETH DANCE, widow of JAMES W. DANCE, deceased, by jury, Feb. Court 1824, Feb. 26, 1824, a tract of 82 acres adjoining BRASWELL and TISDALE.

#436 p. 262 Division of a tract of land that CHRISTOPHER TAYLOR, deceased, left in his will to his son, WILLIAM TAYLOR, deceased, and was to be divided by petition into four lots of 105 acres each for the heirs of WILLIAM TAYLOR, deceased, to wit: MERRY TAYLOR, the heirs of MILES TAYLOR, BENJAMIN BARNES and wife, TEMPERANCE BARNES, and ZILPHA BRANTLEY, Dec. 31, 1823. The land was on the north side of Tar River at the mouth of the Long Branch.

#437 p. 264 Allotment of dower to SARAH POPE, widow of JOSEPH POPE, deceased, by jury, Feb. 8, 1826, a tract of 67 acres adjoining WILLIAM POPE and ARCHIBALD POPE.

* #438 p. 265 Allotment of dower to PRISCILLA WHITFIELD, widow of JACOB WHITFIELD, deceased, by jury, Jan. 29, 1827, a tract of 96-1/3 acres on Pig Basket Creek

adjoining DR. SESSUMS.

#439 p. 266 Division of the negroes of HENRY WALKER, deceased, among his children, Dec. 31, 1823, to wit: WILLIAM VICK in right of his wife, MARTHA VICK, BOLING WALKER, and JAMES WALKER.

#440 p. 267 Division of the negroes of THEOPHILUS GRICE, deceased, by commissioners, Dec. 6, 1824, among JOHN GRICE, RHODA GRICE, TEMPY GRICE, and THOMAS GRICE.

#441 p. 268 Division of the negroes of LEWIS DORTCH, deceased, by commissioners, Nov. Term 1823, Jan. 1, 1824, so as to show the part of PRISCILLA DORTCH, deceased.

#442 p. 269 Allotment of dower to MOURNING HOLLAND, widow of RICHARD HOLLAND, deceased, by jury, Nov. Term 1823, Jan. 21, 1824, after rendering eight days of service, a tract of 728 acres on Sappony Creek or Swamp adjoining WHITFIELD and EVANS.

#443 p. 270 Division of the estate of RICHARD HOLLAND, deceased, by jury, July 26, 1824, so as to allow to the widow, MOURNING HOLLAND, a child's share. The six lots were allotted to the WIDOW, EDWIN BASS, LUCY HOLLAND, JOHN HOLLAND, ELIZABETH BASS, and JOHN GANDY.

#444 p. 272 Division of the negroes of DEMPSEY TAYLOR, deceased, among the heirs, Dec. 14, 1824, to wit: widow MIRIAM TAYLOR, EVERETT EATMAN and wife, SELAH EATMAN, ZEALOUS TAYLOR, MATTHEW TAYLOR, ABEL J. TAYLOR, HANON TAYLOR, JAMES STRICKLAND and wife, DICEY STRICKLAND, JINCY TAYLOR, CINTHIA TAYLOR, and CLARY TAYLOR.

#445 p. 274 Division of the lands of JOHN GAY, deceased, by commissioners, Feb. Term 1809, May 3, 1809. Lots were received by the following: BETHANY BASS, ELIAS GAY, JOSIAH GAY, MILLS GAY, JORDAN GAY, ELIZABETH GAY, WILLIS GAY, JAMES GAY, JOHN GAY, MOURNING GAY, and NANCY HUNT. Each heir received a tract of 33-1/2 acres and BETHANY BASS received Lot #1, in-

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
