

DIED.

BUTTERFIELD—At Herriman, Utah, April 2nd, 1890, of old age, Thomas Butterfield, son of Martha and Zachariah Butterfield; born June 17th, 1811, in Farmington, Kennebeck Co., Me. Deceased was baptized into the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in May, 1834, at Farmington. He gathered with the Saints at Kirtland, Ohio, in 1836, and in 1838 went to Jackson County, Mo. He, with others, was driven from Missouri by the mob in 1839, and afterwards settled at Quincy, Ills. He removed to near Nauvoo, Ills., in 1841, and was ordained a member of the third quorum of Seventies shortly after. He was expelled from Illinois with the Saints in 1846, and from that place went to Council Bluffs, where he remained for two years. He removed to Utah in 1849, and settled at West Jordan, where he dwelt until 1851, then removed to Herriman. The deceased was true and faithful to the last. He was the father of 17 children, 77 grandchildren and 18 great grandchildren.

The funeral services were held at the ward meeting house at Herriman, April 7th
