### Description

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State of North Carolina, In the Probate Court. WAYNE COUNTY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Jackson Hamrell, Joseph Sauls, John Cook & Jethro Cook

are held and firmly bound unto the State of North Carolina, in the sum of Twenty five Hundred Dollars, (Double the amount of all the property, real and personal, of the deceased.) to the payment whereof well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, jointly and severally, our executors and administrators, firmly by these presents.

Sealed this 27th day of December, 1889.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That if the above bounden Jackson Hamrell of James Mooring, deceased, do make a true and perfect inventory, and account of sales of all the real estate, and all the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, which have or shall come to his possession or knowledge, and the same do exhibit into the Probate Court of said County, within three months after the date hereof, and do well and truly administer according to law, all the goods, chattels, rights and credits of said deceased, and the proceeds of all his real estate, that may be sold for the payment of the debts of said deceased, which shall at any time come to the possession of the said Administrator or to the possession of any other person for him, and further, do make a true and just account of his said administration within two years after the date hereof, and all the rest and residue of the said proceeds of real estate, goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining upon his account, (the same being first examined and allowed by the Judge of Probate) shall deliver and pay to such person, as the same shall be due unto: and shall obey all lawful orders of the said Probate, or other Court, touching the administration of the estate committed to him, and shall faithfully execute the trust reposed in him as such Administrator according to law, then this obligation to be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
