



James Long Family. Three Children Saved, Three Lost

But one more body was recovered today, Bringing the total found to date to 178. It was identified as Ray Long, oldest son of James Long. Mr. Long's residence was near the depot. His wife was an invalid, and when the flood came he ran out with three children - two girls and a boy, the last under 5 years. He hurried them into the depot and returned to get his wife, or to help his other three children. All were lost, except the three in the depot. F.G. Hart, the assistant O.R. & N agent, seized them, together with the little daughter of J.M. Kernan, the regular station agent, and made for the hills back of the depot. Though up to his armpits for a time in the rushing waters, he managed to keep hold of the four children, until higher ground was reached.
