Will of John Floyd of St. Mark's Parish of Culpeper Co., being aged  
and in very sick and low condition of Health.

Dated 21 March, 1770. Proven 18 July, 1770.

I lend to my beloved wife, Jane Floyd, my land whereon I now live and  
all my personal estate. After decease of my said wife land to be held by  
Nathaniel Pendleton until my son or heir-at-law do appear and legally  
claim the same.

Executrix: Wife.

Inventory taken 18 July, 1770 and returned by Jane Floyd, Extrx.

Will of Joseph Belfield of Culpeper Co.

Dated 9 Aug., 176\_. Proven 1 July, 1770.

Legatees: Brother William Glass and nephew Belfield Cave, slaves  
divided equally with survivor to have all. If both die, then to brother-  
in-law Benjamin Cave and sister Elizabeth Cave.

Also mentioned cash, furniture, etc., in same manner.

Executor: Brother-in-law Benjamin Cave.

Dated 24 Jan., 1774. Proven 21 Feb., 1774.

Legatees: Wife Rachel Conner. Children (all minors): Mary, John, Elizabeth, Philemon and the child my wife is now pregnant with.
