★ Unlawful Cohabitations, St. Mary Ann's Parish (From the Parish Vestry Proceedings, 1749-1776)

John Key (Keyes) and Mary Skurry (Scurry), wife of Thomas Scurry, admonished in May, 1749 and again in Nov., 1751, but they were still unlawfully cohabiting in March, 1752.
 John Howard and Alice Walley were admonished in July, 1750. Alexander McIntosh and Alice Howard admonished in Dec. 1752.
 Lewis Lee and Rebecca Childs were admonished in Aug., 1756, but they were still unlawfully cohabiting in March, 1757.
 Charles Ragon and the widow Death were cited in August, 1756 but they appeared with a marriage certificate signed by Mr. William Lindsay, a minister living in Pennsylvania.
 Jonas Cooper of Charles Town, cordwainer, and Elizabeth Jackson were cited in March, 1759, but Rev. John Hamilton informed the Vestry that he had since married them.
 Walter Rodgers and Martha his supposed wife were cited in March 1759, but Rev. Hamilton stated he had married them.
 William Lashell and Elizabeth Ryan cited in November, 1761, and ordered to produce a marriage certificate by Easter.
 Ralph Rutter of Charles Town and Liddy Wells (widow), she being with child, were admonished in November, 1761.
 Joseph Elliot of Charles Town and Sarah Brumfield (Brumfeld), she being big with child, were cited in November, 1761.
 William Merchant and Jane Armstrong were cited in November, 1761, but reportedly had moved out of Maryland.
 Thomas Beetle and Sylvia Jones were admonished in Dec. 1765.
 Samuel Faris and Elizabeth White were cited in November, 1765 and appeared in March, 1766, reportedly married.
 John Magruder and Elizabeth Jackson were cited in November, 1765 and by March 1766 he had reportedly left the county.
 Charles Brookins and Margaret Gordon were cited, Sept., 1766.
 Jacob Johnson and Rebecca Hawkins were cited in Sept., 1766.
 James Wareham and Sabina McDowell (widow) were cited in June 1767.
 They appeared and were admonished in August 1767.
 Mordecai Cloud and Elizabeth Connolly were cited, Oct. 1767.
 Alexander Butler and Hester Hughes were cited in Oct., 1767.
 Edward Bryan and Lydia Wells were cited in August, 1786 and subsequently appeared and were admonished by the Vestry.
 Edward Welden and Mary Campbell were cited in October, 1768.
