*Abraham Howard*; immigrated to New England around 1720; had been a shipmaster involved in trade in the Mediterranean; was captured by Algerians and held as a slave for several years until released under treaty between England and Algiers; upon release, came to America; settled in Marblehead, Massachusetts, around 1722; had a son Joseph.

*Benjamin Howard*; immigrated to Virginia in 1646.

*Cornelius Howard*; one of five brothers who emigrated from England to Maryland in 1658; settled on the Severn River.

✓ *Edmund Howard*; died 1713; emigrated from England to Somerset County, Maryland, around the mid-seventeenth century; justice of Somerset County Court, 1689; clerk of Charles County, Maryland; married to Margaret Dent on 26 May 1681; children were Rebecca, William Stevens, George, John, Thomas, Elizabeth, and Edmund.

*Edward Howard*; immigrated to Virginia in 1651.

*Edward Howard*; immigrated to Virginia in 1637.

✓ *George Howard*; emigrated from Southwark, Surrey, to Maryland on 3 February 1724, aged 19; indentured servant.

*Henry Howard*; died 1709; immigrated to Wethersfield, Connecticut, in or prior to 1648; married to Sarah Stone in 1648; children were Sarah (died young), Sarah, Elizabeth, John, Lydia, Mary, and Samuel.

*Henry Howard*; emigrated from England to Virginia between the years 1663 and 1679.

*James Howard*; immigrated to Virginia in 1656.

*James Howard*; emigrated from Somersetshire to Virginia on 26 January 1729, aged 19; indentured servant.

*James Howard*; emigrated from London to Virginia on board the ship *Adventurer* in January 1775, aged 25; engraver; indentured servant.

*James Howard*; transported\* from Essex to Virginia on board the ship *Forward Frigate* on 8 October 1726; indentured servant.

*John Howard*; born 1620, died 1700; emigrated from England to Duxbury, Massachusetts, around 1635; surveyor; innkeeper; carpenter; admitted freeman in 1646; later became one of the fifty-four original settlers and proprietors of Bridgewater, Massachusetts; ensign in the militia, 27 September 1664; lieutenant, 2 October 1689; deputy to the General Court from 1678 to 1683; married to Martha Hayward around 1651; children were John, James, Jonathan, Elizabeth, Sarah, Bethiah, and Ephraim.

*John Howard*; transported from Chelmsford, England, to Maryland on board the ship *Gilbert* on 27 October 1720; indentured servant. \*

*John Howard*; transported from Newgate Prison to Maryland on board the ship *Supply* on 25 February 1725/26; indentured servant. \*

*John Howard*; emigrated from Sussex to Maryland on board the ship *Jane* in January 1775, aged 22; painter; indentured servant. \*

*John Howard*; one of five brothers who emigrated from England to Maryland in 1658; settled on the Severn River. \*

*John Howard*; emigrated from Culliton Rawley, Devonshire, to either Pennsylvania or Maryland on 4 February 1723, aged 20; carpenter; indentured servant. \*

*John Howard*; emigrated from Laindon, Essex, to Pennsylvania on 9 February 1738, aged 19; shoemaker; indentured servant. \*

*John Howard*; transported from Newgate Prison to Virginia on board the

\* There were no less than 150 capital crimes in England for which a man might be transported. Of course, there were the expected ones of murder, arson, and treason, but there were also lesser ones such as maiming, stealing a cow, cutting down trees along an avenue, sending threatening letters, and standing mute when addressed by a legal official. Some convicts were even people of quality. One gentleman of high birth, for instance, was transported for stealing books out of a library. As a child, George Washington was taught to read and write by a transported convict who had been a schoolmaster. Especially in the countryside, the crimes which resulted in transportation were often very petty. One man was transported for stealing a silver shoebuckle. Another was sent to America and indentured for seven years for the theft of a chicken.

*Robert Howard*; emigrated from Westminster, Middlesex, to Maryland on 18 February 1720, aged 19; cordwainer; indentured servant. \*

form. They are, however, considered accurate and complete. Unfortunately, the Capitol was burned by the British forces during the War of 1812, and the schedules for the areas that constituted the present states of Delaware, Georgia, Kentucky, New Jersey, Tennessee, and Virginia were destroyed.

The records which escaped destruction have proven inestimably valuable, for they show a complete listing of the heads of all families living in the United States at the time of the adoption of the Constitution. These schedules contain over 400,000 names, and since each family averages six persons, historians have estimated the population of the country in 1790 to have been approximately 3,231,533.

Below are listed the names of all the heads of families bearing the name **Howard** in twelve of the thirteen original states (the schedules of Delaware having been destroyed in 1812 and those of Virginia having been reconstructed from state enumerations taken in the years 1782, 1783, and 1785). The list numbers over 700 family heads in the states of Connecticut, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Vermont, and Virginia. Following the name is the county or district (in the case of North and South Carolina) of domicile of the particular individual. Additional names from a reconstructed 1800 census schedule (compiled from lists of taxpayers) for the state of Kentucky are also included.

American Revolution

Once England had defeated the French in North America it was inevitable that she seek to devote her energies to the *use* of her colonies which the century of French wars had impeded. But the American colonies did not wish to be used and instead wanted more of what the frontier of America had created: freedom and personal sovereignty. If England had been wise, she would have realized this and perhaps extended political and economic sovereignty bit by bit for another generation or two. Then a war need never have been fought.

Instead, selfishly, England laid hands on her independent and spirited American children and told them roughly to work, not for themselves, but for England three thousand miles away. And she found to her loss that the children had grown into strong men.

The information in the following list of **Howard** Revolutionary veterans includes not only those patriots who actually fought in military units, but also those who did patriotic service in a variety of industries such as making uniforms, gunsmithing, collecting provisions and performing medical and surgeon's duties. Births, deaths, and marriages as well as units, ranks, and distinctions are noted to make this list as complete as possible for the identification of the individuals contained in it.
