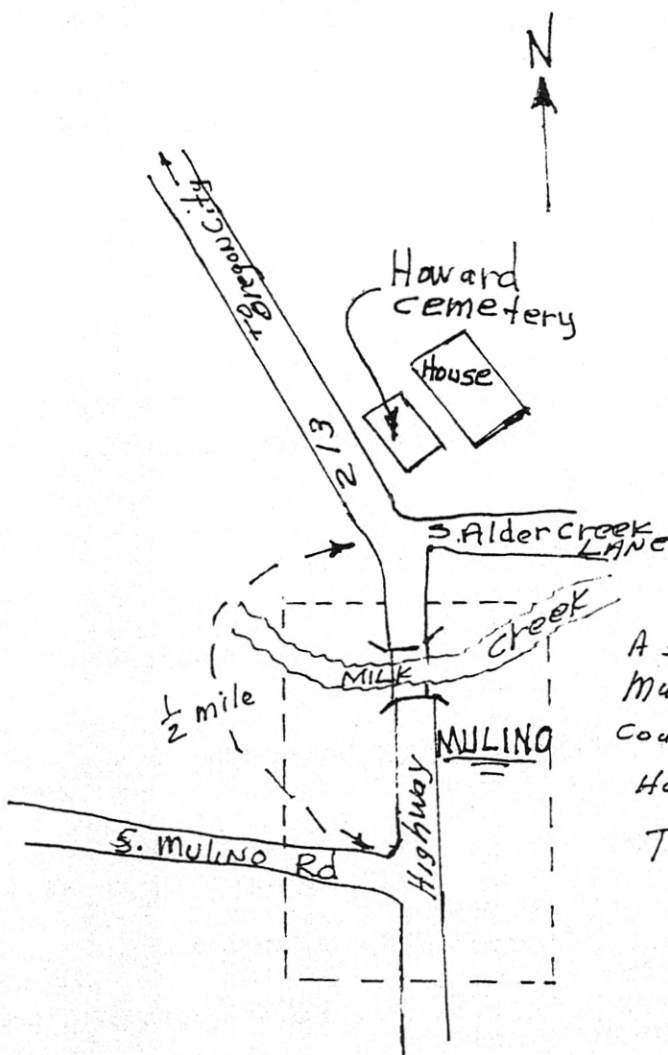

HOWARD CEMETERY

This cemetery is located at the top of a bank before you enter Mulino. It was established in pioneer days and is no longer in use. There are four tombstones. There are other graves nearby but they are lost due to the land being used for a new road. It is said there are still some buried under the road. There were approximately 20 graves. The cemetery is now closed. The condition is fair and there is no sexton at this time.

Son of R.R. & C.

HOWARD, Cynthia Oct 9, 1810 - Jul 20, 1877
A loving Mother, a beautiful wife, a devoted christian

HOWARD, Richard R. Nov 18, 1797 - Nov 14, 1865
An honest Man in the noblest work of God

OFFICER, Sarah HOWARD Mar 30, 1838 - Jun 10, 1861

OFFICER, Eliz CASEY Jun 24, 1831 - Nov 29, 1896
Son of James Eveline COOLEY

There are three children and 10 or 12 Indians buried under the old house that still stands. The old road used to go around the back of the house and down the hill.
