place of William Reynolds.  
(Note: James Trimble says of him: "Wm Howell, emigrated  
fr Castle Bigt in Pembrokeshire, Wales, in company  
with Lewis David, & Henry Lewis, & settled in Haverford  
Twp, Chester Co, PA, in 1682; he doubtless had several  
ch; among his probable descendants are: Samuel Howell,  
resided in the northern part of E Nottingham; rem to  
Chester MM, 20-1-1741; Israel Howell, rem fr Chester  
to Nottingham in 1748; Wm Howell, doubtless a descendant  
of Wm the emigrant, lived in W Nottingham Hundred,  
Cecil Co, MD, s of John & Ann Howell, & was b 1-2-1776;  
d 9 mo-1857; & m Hannah Pugh, dt John & Rachel (Barrett)  
Pugh (See his record)  
At the mtg held 19-6-1732, W Nottingham PM "offers  
Richard Brown in ye place of an overseer, instead of  
Wm Howell, late dec, which this Mtg approves until  
further orders."
