A, 630-631: Benedict Koone of Ninety Six District, SC, planter, to give to Christiana Booth, tract of 50 acres in the fork between Broad and Saludy Rivers on a branch of Crims Creek, part of tract granted to Andreas Meyer, 500 acres, which the said Benedict Koone bought of said Andreas Meyer, dated 18 Aug 1788. Benedict Koone (mark) (Seal), Wit: Abraham Chapman (AC), George Risor, Henry Summers. Proved by the oath of Abraham Chapman 17 Feb 1789 before Robert Rutherford, J.P. Recorded 18 Apr 1789.

A, 631-633: 4 March 1786, James Cato of Newberry County to Andrew Yeagain of same, for £100 sterling, 200 acres in the fork between Broad & Saludy River in the fork of Kings Creek, it being a branch of Enoree River, granted to James Cato Sen'r 23 June 1774, entered in the Auditor Generals office in Book M. No. 13, page 101, 14 Nov 1784 [sic], entered in the Secretary's office in Book QQQ, page 518. James Cato (C) (Seal), Wit: Edward Finch, Abner Casey, James Vardaman. Proved 2 April 1789 by the oath of Edward Finch before Levi Casey, J.P. Recorded 20 April 1789.

A, 633-636: Lease and release. 1 & 2 Dec 1788, Charles Neill, of Newberry County, planter, to William Speakman Jun'r of same, for £75 sterling, 150 acres on south side of Bush River commonly known by the name of Charles Neills old place. Charles Neill (Seal), Mary Neill (X) (Seal), Wit: James Lindsey, Thomas Speakman, William Speakman Sen'r (mark). Proved 3 March 1789 by the oath of James Lindsey before W. Wadlington, J.P. Recorded 20 April 1789.

A, 636-637: 16 Feb 1789, James Vardaman, planter, of Newberry County, 96 District, to William Smith, farmer, for £60 sterling, tract on south side Enoree River granted to James Vardaman 5 June 1786, entered in Book LLL.L., page 437, 200 acres. James Vardaman (Seal), Jean Vardaman (X) (Seal), Wit: W. Malone Sen'r, George Johnson, Simon Park (P). Proved by the oath of Simon Park 21 Feb 1789 before Robert Rutherford, J.P. Recorded 24 April 1789.

A, 638: State of South Carolina, Newberry County. William Johnston of Newberry County for £55 sterling to John Johnston, planter, of same, one bay stallion about 15 hands high, 190 years old, a lump in his breast, a blaze in his forehead, a full blooded horse, 17 Jan 1788 the original bill of sale given by James Sharp to me, dated 29 Jan 1788. William Johnston (Seal), Wit: Benjamin Butler (+), Elizabeth Butler (+). Proved in Newberry County by the oath of William Johnston 9 May 1789 before John Lindsey, J.P.

A, 639-641: Lease and release. 7 & 8 Jan 1787, Abraham Gray, of Laurens County, Ninety Six District, saddler, to Charles King of Newberry County, same

district, for £100 sterling, 103 acres on Indian Creek adj. land laid out to Abraham Pennington, John Garret, unknown owners, granted to said Gray 2 May 1785, recorded in Book DDDD. Abraham Gray (Seal), Wit: John Odell, William Finch, Wm Gray. Proved 27 Jan 1787 before Levi Casey, J.P., by the oath of Wm Finch. Recorded 18 May 1789.

A, 642-645: Lease and release. 7 & 8 Jan 1788, William Wadlington of Newberry County, Ninety Six District, to William Gilreath of same, planter, for £100 sterling, 200 acres in Berkly County in the fork between Broad & Saludy Rivers on a small branch of Kings Creek adj. James Murphy, recorded in Book OOO, page 473, granted 2 April 1773 to William Wadlington. W. Wadlington (Seal), Wit: Robert Rutherford, Thomas Mathis, Henry Slappy. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of Henry Slappy 16 May 1789 before Robert Rutherford, J.P. Recorded 19 May 1789.

A, 645-648: Lease and release. 18 Oct 1786, Robert Gilliam of Newberry County to Daniel Clark of Edgefield County, for £50 sterling, 200 acres granted to Joseph Freeman 26 Sept 1772 adj. Robert Gilliam, Samuel Proctor, Sarah Proctor, conveyed by Joseph Freeman to Robert Gilliam. Robert Gilliam (Seal), Wit: John Jones (+), Delph Day (mark), Susannah Jones (+). Proved in Newberry County by the oath of John Jones 28 Feb 1789 before James Mayson, J.P. Recorded 19 May 1789.

A, 649-650: 15 Oct 1788, Abel Anderson and Rosanna his wife of Newberry County to William Ragland of Wilks County, North Carolina, for £115 Virginia money, 150 acres in Newberry County on both sides Kings Creek, a branch of Enoree River, being a tract granted to Abel Anderson 18 Jan 1765, entered in the Auditors office in Book G, No. 7, page 219, 26 Feb 1765. Abel Anderson (Seal), Rosanah Anderson (Seal), Wit: Charles Crenshaw, Rosanah Anderson (mark), Rachael Anderson (+). Proved in Newberry County 14 Jan 1789 by the oath of Charles Crenshaw before John Lindsey, J.P.

A, 651-652: 28 Feb 1789, Thomas Gordon, 1.sqr., to Awbrey Noland, Gentleman, both of Newberry County, for £9 s15 sterling, 13 acres on south side of Tyger River between that river & Enoree on Peters Creek, adj. Noland, Crawlis?], granted by Arthur Dobbs, Gov of NC, to George Robinson 13 Oct 1756 and since purchased by John Mitchel and afterwards purchased by said Thomas Gordon 8 Dec 1785, also granted to John Mitchell by SC 1 March 1775. Thos Gordon (Seal), Wit: N. Kelly, Jesse Gordon, Mary Gordon (+). Acknowledged in open court 4 March 1789. Recorded 19 May 1789.

A, 652-653: Joshua Law of Ninety Six District, Newberry County, Doctor, appoints friend Mercer Babb his attorney, to recover or receive of and from all my customers for _____ and medicine, 11 Feb 1789. Joshua Law (Seal), Wit: James Wadlington, Margaret Wadlington (mark). Proved in Newberry County by the oath of Margaret Wadlington 4 March 1789 before W. Wadlington, J.P.

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- A, 653-657:** Lease and release. 9 & 10 Dec 1785, John Bearden & Mary Simpson his mother of Camden District, SC, to Elizabeth Tinsley of Ninety Six District, for £500 former currency of SC, 200 acres on Little River in Ninety Six District, granted to William Bearden 1 Feb 1768, to which the said John Bearden and Mary Simpson his Mother became seized by virtue of being sole heir at law to William Bearden deceased. John Bearden (Seal), Mary Simpson (X) (Seal). Wit: John Golding, Richard Golding, James Tinsley. Proved by the oath of James Tindsley 2 March 1789 before William Caldwell, J.P. Recorded 20 May 1789.
- A, 657-661:** Lease and release. 28 & 29 Dec 1784, William Sutcliff of St. Johns Parish, SC, to John Wallace of Ninety Six District, for £20 sterling, 100 acres on Goosepond Creek, waters of Saluda in Ninety Six District, adj. Robert Ditton, Thomas Clark, estate of James Dyson decd, granted to William Sutcliff 11 Jan 1773, recorded in Book FFF, page 133. William Sutcliffe (Seal), wit: Richard Morris, Thomas Threadcraft, Silvester Sutcliff. Proved 5 Jan 1785 by the oath of Richard Morris before George Ruff, J.P. Recorded 21 May 1789.
- A, 661:** Darcus Largent of Newberry County, Ninety Six District, for £45 14 3 paid at or before 8 Nov 1785 by John Wallace of same district and county, negro girl named Peggy about 14 years of age, dated 8 Nov 1785. Darcus Largent (+) (Seal), Wit: Wm Anderson, Samuel Savage. Recorded 28 May 1789.
- A, 662:** Amry Day of Laurance County, Ninety Six District for £40 sterling to John Wallace of Newberry County, negro girl named Venus about 15 years of age, dated 31 May 1788. Amry Day (X) (Seal), Wit: John Saterwhite, Robert Gillam. Recorded 28 May 1789.
- A, 663:** South Carolina, Newberry County. Before Robert Gillam, J. P., appeared Comfort Stephens and saith that William Winchester Jun'r was born out of wedlock and before she the said Comfort and William Winchester Sen'r was married and that William Winchester Jun'r was no heir to the estate of William Winchester Sen'r but that Daniel Winchester is the Real Heir, 11 March 1787. Comfort Stephens (C). Robert Gillam, J.P.
- Richland County. Before me A. B. Ross, J. P. for said county, appeared a woman named Sarah Majors and make oath that William Winchester Jun'r son of Comfort Polson now Stephens was born before wedlock to her knowledge, 7 Aug 1788. Sarah Majors (+), A. B. Ross, J.P.
- Before A. B. Ross appeared Sarah Majors and saith that Comfort Winchester now Comfort Stephens was married to William Winchester Sr nearly a year after William Winchester Jun'r was born & that Daniel Winchester is her son and born in wedlock, 7 Aug 1788. Sarah Majors (+), A. B. Ross, J.P. Recorded 29 May 1789.
- A, 664:** South Carolina, Newberry County. Thomas Burton had sold all my property both in my house & out of doors to Charles Lowry for £100 sterling, 15 Aug 1788. Thomas Burton (Seal). Wit: John Lowry, Charles Lowry. Recorded 29 May 1789.
- A, 664-667:** 8 Nov 1774, Jacob Farington of Craven County, SC, Ninety Six District, Blacksmith, to Sarah Speak of same, widow, for £150 SC money. 100 acres on waters of Indian Creek granted to said Jacob Farington on Pattersons Creek adj. William Cannon, John Patterson, Mr. Cashaw, Thos Wadlington, Charles King, Jas Catter in Berkly County. Jacob Farington (Seal). Wit: John Hudgins, Samuel Davis, James Lindsey. Proved 3 Sept 1788 by the oath of James Lindsey before John Lindsey, J.P. Recorded 22 June 1789.
- A, 667-668:** 2 March 1789, Mary, wife of William Turner of Ninety Six, SC, relinquished dower for indenture 13 Aug 1788 to Philemon Waters for 750 acres on north side Saludy River adj. Edward Brown, Joseph King not property of heirs of John Lark, also tract of 60 acres on north side Big Saludy River adj. John Lark. Mary Turner (mark) (Seal) before James Mayson and Jacob Rt's Brown, J.P. Acknowledged by private examination 2 March 1789.
- A, 669-672:** Lease and release. 3 March 1789, Thomas Brooks of Newberry County, Ninety Six District, farmer, & Susannah his wife, to Margaret Pearson and Enoch Pearson, extx & extr. of the will of Benjamin Pearson, decd., for £100 SC money, 200 acres on a branch of Saludy call'd Beaver Dam adj. land of Caleb Gilbert, James Johnson, certified 5 Sept 1769 by John Caldwell, D.S. Thomas Brooks (Seal), Susanna Brooks (Seal), Wit: James Goodman, Abel Pearson, Robert Pearson. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of James Goodman 3 March 1789 before Thos. W. Waters, J.P. Recorded 24 June 1789.
- A, 673-675:** Lease and release. 12 & 13 March 1788, Joseph Summers of Ninety Six District to Giles Chapman of same, for £50 sterling, 125 acres on the waters of Bush River adj. Timothy Thomas, Joseph Mooney, John Mills, Enoch Pearson, Joseph Summers, at the wagon road leading to Charleston. Joseph Summers (Seal), Wit: Thos. W. Waters, William Summers, Richard Clagg. Proved by the oath of Thos W. Waters 5 March 1789 before J. Robt's Brown. Recorded 26 June 1789.
- A, 676-679:** Lease and release. 17 & 18 Oct 1786, John Wallace of Newberry County to Allen Cox of same, for £50 sterling, 100 acres on the bounty adj. land surveyed for Robert Dillon, Thomas Clark, granted to William Sutcliff 6 Feb 1773 and conveyed to said John Wallace 29 Dec 1784. John Wallace (Seal), Wit: Wm Anderson, Timothy Cooper, Thomas Farquhar. Proved 2 March 1789 by the oath of Wm Anderson before James Mayson, J.P. Recorded 29 June 1789.
- A, 679-680:** John Edwards of Newberry County, Ninety Six District, for £40 sterling to Elizabeth Turner of same, two horses, one yearling mare colt, three negroes Frank, Lydda, and Moses, three cows & calves, two sows & pigs, two

C, 30-31: 21 Feb 1794, Charles Griffin and Mary his wife of Newberry County to Reuben Griffin of same, for £68 sterling, 130 acres originally granted to Jonathan Mote 20 Jan 1773 adj. land of Jacob Gray, Michael Rey, James Griffin, Wm Johnson, and land for the meeting house. Charles Griffin (Seal), Mary Griffin (X), Wit: Alexander Simpson, John Gray (X), Frankey Griffin (X). Proved by the oath of Alexander Simpson 2 May 1794 before Providence Williams, J.P. Recorded 7 Jan 1795.

C, 32-33: 21 Feb 1794, Charles Griffin and Mary his wife of Newberry County to Reuben Griffin of same, for £68 sterling, 100 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres on west side and north side of the Quaker Branch, part of 350 acres originally granted 12 Dec 1768 to James Griffin deceased, adj. land granted to Jonathan Mote. Charles Griffin (Seal), Mary Griffin (X), Wit: Alexander Simpson, John Gray (X), Frankey Griffin (X). Proved by the oath of Alexander Simpson 2 May 1794 before Providence Williams, J.P. Recorded 7 Jan 1795.

C, 34-37: Lease and release. 14 & 15 March 1794, Joseph Coppock of Newberry County, planter, to Thomas Coppock, blacksmith, of same, for £100 sterling, 250 acres, part of 400 acres on Bush Creek, granted to John Ridgedell 22 March 169 and conveyed in part, viz 250 acres to Joseph Coppock 12 Oct 1784. Joseph Coppock (Seal), Wit: David Miles, Thomas Haskit, John Coppock. Proved 24 Nov 1794 by the oath of Thomas Haskit before Mercer Babb, J.P. Recorded 16 Jan 1795.

C, 38-40: Lease and release. 13 & 14 Oct 1794, Enoch Smith of Pendleton County, SC, to Azariah Pugh of Newberry County, for £80 sterling, 205 acres on waters of Bush River granted to Enoch Smith 4 Dec 1786, recorded in Book PPPP, page 251, adj. Joseph Scott, John Mills, land formerly of Azariah Pugh Senr, and William Aspinell. Enoch Smith (Seal), Wit: Samuel Looper, Joseph Looper, Moses Smith. Proved in Newberry County 17 Oct 1794 by the oath of Moses Smith before Mercer Babb, J.P. Recorded 19 Jan 1795.

C, 41-42: 1 Dec 1794, Samuel Proctor Senr of Newberry County, for natural love and affection to son in law Joseph White, part of 350 acres granted to said Samuel Proctor 13 May 1768 on Pages Creek, waters of Mudlick Creek, to be divided: to son Philip Proctor 50 acres, to son Edward 50 acres, to nephew Samuel Adams, 50 acres, the remainder of 300 acres to Joseph White. Saml Proctor Senr (mark) (Seal), Wit: Thos Wm. Fakes, Stephen Vetto, John Proctor. Proved by the oath of Stephen Vetto 7 Jan 1795 before James Mayson, J.N.C. Recorded 21 Jan. 1795.

C, 43-45: Lease and release. 9 & 10 Oct 1794, Henry Coate & his wife Mary of Newberry County to Francis Atkins of same, for £15 sterling, 57 acres on waters of Scotch Creek, a branch of Bush River, adj Benjamin Atkins, Francis Atkins, Joseph Scott, William Jenkins, Little John Coate, granted to Henry Coate 29 Oct 1794. Henry Coate (Seal), Mary Coate (X) (Seal), Wit: George Goggans, Thomas Atkins, John Coate. Proved by the oath of John Coate 13 Oct 1794 before Peter Julin, J.P. Recorded 21 Jan. 1795.

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Wm Webster, Wm Wilson. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of William Webster 16 Dec 1794 before John Speake, J.P. Recorded 30 Dec 1794.

C, 20-24: Lease and release. 26 Nov 1791, Joshua Inman Senr., planter, of Newberry County, to John Marbutt, planter, of same, for £40 sterling, 50 acres on waters of Bush River adj. Frederick Burtz, John Inman, Mercer Babb, Esqr., half of 100 acres granted to Rufus Inman 10 June 1774 and conveyed by him to Joshua Inman Senr 14 & 15 Oct [year not indicated]. Joshua Inman, Wit: Aaron Coppock, James Barrett. Proved 26 Nov 1791 by the oath of Aaron Coppock before Mercer Babb, J.P. Recorded 5 Jan 1795.

C, 25: Benjamin Butler of Newberry County to Willis Butler of same, three feather beds & furniture, one roan mare, one bay horse, five head of cattle, 12 head of hogs, 50 bushels of corn & one iron pott, & half dozen plats, two basons, one shovel plow, 14 March 1794. Benjamin Butler (X) (Seal), Wit: John Butler, Wm. Butler. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of William Butler 9 March 1794 before Pro. Williams, J.P. Recorded 6 Jan 1795.

C, 26: South Carolina, Newberry County. Personally appear'd before me Charity Mills & Makes oath that about two years & ten months ago her husband lost a number of hogs, stray'd away amongst which was an old black sow marked with a crop & slit in each ear, also a number of other hogs same mark, others not marked at all, 10 Dec 1794. Charity Mills (X), before Peter Julien, J.P.

Rebekah Mills makes oath that her father marked with a crop & slit in each & particular remembers there loosing the black saw mentioned within.

Thomas W. Waters makes oath he took up seven hogs, six of which had the above mark & believes them to be the same. Thos. W. Waters.

Peter Lester makes oath that he was one of the appraisers that valued such hogs for said Waters & they valued them at Eleven dollars. Peter Lester (X). Recorded 6 Jan 1795.

C, 27-28: South Carolina, Ninety Six District. 19 Oct 1794, James Virden & Sarah his wife of Newberry County to Charles Hewit of same, for £120 sterling, 200 acres on south side Enoree River adj. Isaac Pennington, Edeniah Virden, granted 5 June 1786. James Verden (X) (Seal), Sarah Verden (mark) (Seal), Wit: W. Kelly, William Nabours, James Cater. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of Ja's Cato 30 July 1794 before John Speake, J.P. Recorded 6 Jan 1795.

C, 29: Rachel Waters of Newberry County for natural love and affection to my son Dennis Lark, one negroe girl named Anica about 8 years old, 15 Nov 1794. Rachel Waters (Seal), Wit: Cullen Lark, M. W. Moon. Proved 20 Nov in Newberry County by the oath of Cullen Lark before Mercer Babb, J.P. Recorded 6 Jan 1795.

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Egenia Virden. Egenia Virden (Seal), Wit: Leroy Buford, Jno Voluntine. Proved by the oath of John Voluntine 1 March 1796 before Levi Casey, J.N.C. Recorded 2 June 1796.

C, 738-739: 6 Dec 1796, Zachariah Smith Brooks and Elizabeth his wife of Ninety Six District to James Spearman of same, for £200 sterling, 200 acres on waters of Little River adj. Wm Hugiins, granted in 1769. Zachariah S. Brooks (Seal), Elizabeth Brooks (Seal), Wit: Daniel Goggans, John Adkison, Edmd Spearman. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of Edmond Spearman 16 May 1796 before Fred Nance, J.P. Recorded 9 June 1796.

C, 740-741: 4 Nov 1795, James Daugherty of Orangeburgh District to John Livingston of Ninety Six District for £10 sterling, 150 acres on waters of Second Creek adj. Joseph Caldwell, John Taylor, part of 500 acres granted to said Daugherty 7 May 1787, recorded in Book TTTT, page 122. James Daugherty (Seal), Wit: Peter Richardson (mark), James McCart (mark), Franky Richardson (mark). Proved in Newberry County by the oath of Peter Richardson 25 Jan 1796 before Thomas W. Waters, J.P. Recorded 9 June 1796.

C, 742-743: 18 Feb 1796, John Michael Kromer of Newberry County to George Henry Suber of same, for £20, 112½ acres, part of two tracts: the SW part of tract of 250 acres granted to John Michael Kromer 9 Jan 1755 recorded in Book PP, page 285 on Campen Creek, waters of Saluda River; the SW part of 200 acres granted to said John Michael Kromer 25 May 1774, recorded in Book FFF, page 392 on waters of Campen Creek. John Michael Kromer (Seal), Wit: Abraham Chapman (AC). George Swigart, George Harbirt. Proved in Orangeburgh District by the oath of Abraham Chapman 2 May 1796 before John Hampton, J.Q. Recorded 9 June 1796.

C, 743-746: 19 March 1796, Lewis Hogg and Clary his wife of Newberry County to William Gilliam of same, for £150 sterling, 100 acres on a branch of Broad River called Enoree granted to John Clarke 1 Dec 1769. Lewis Hogg (Seal), Clary Hogg (X) (Seal), Wit: John Henderson, W. Wadlington, Charles Littleton. Proved by the oath of William Wadlington 14 May 1796 before Edward Finch, J.P. Recorded 10 June 1796.

C, 746-749: 19 March 1796, Lewis Hogg and Clary his wife of Newberry County to William Gilliam of same, for £150 sterling, 250 acres on a branch of Broad River called Enoree granted to Benjamin Hampton 17 June 1774. Lewis Hogg (Seal), Clary Hogg (X) (Seal). Wit: John Henderson, W. Wadlington, Charles Littleton. Proved by the oath of William Wadlington 14 May 1796 before Edward Finch, J.P. Recorded 10 June 1796.

C, 750-752: 17 Feb 1796, Thomas Hogg and Martha his wife of Newberry County to William Gilliam of same, for £100 sterling, 100 acres on a branch of Broad River called Enoree granted to John Hogg Senr by will, it being left to his son Thomas Hogg, half of 200 acre tract granted 22 Nov 1771. Thomas

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C, 722-723: 15 May 1796, Elizabeth McDaniel of Newberry County for natural love to son Hambleton McDaniel & grandson James Wallace, son of William Wallace, 100 acres of land on waters of Indian Creek, which said land I give to my son Hambleton McDaniel, he at the time my grandson James Wallace arrives to the age of 21, shall pay to said grandson the value of half of the aforesaid 100 acres; also to my son Hambleton McDaniel, one bay mare 4 years old; to my grandson James Wallace, one dark bay mare. Elizabeth McDaniel (mark) (Seal), Wit: Fred Nance, J.P., William Craig. Recorded 15 May 1796.

C, 723-727: Lease and release. 1 & 2 Nov 1790, Jacob Chandler, taylor, and Ann his wife, of Newberry County to Israel Chandler, son of Jacob, of same, for £25 sterling, 50 acres on waters of Bush River, part of 100 acres purchased of William Gilliland deceased 4 Aug 1774, which said tract was laid off by John Caldwell, Esqr., deceased, and joins old tract of 400 acres on the south side adj. Thomas Ryals, Gilliland. Jacob Chandler (Seal), Ann Chandler (Seal), Wit: John Thomas S. M., David Miles, Isaac Case. Proved in Newberry County by the oath of John Thomas S. M. 14 Feb 1792 before Mercer Babb, J.P. Recorded 16 May 1796.

C, 728-733: Lease and release. 1 & 2 Nov 1790, Jacob Chandler, taylor, and Ann his wife, of Newberry County to Jonathan Chandler, son of Jacob, of same, for £102 sterling, 204 acres on north side of Bush River, by plat laid off by David Pugh 14 Oct 1790 at the request of Jacob Chandler, adj Samuel Coates, the other part of said tract is conveyed to Israel Chandler, part of 300 acres granted 13 Aug 1762 to Abraham Caradine and conveyed to Israel Fulson 7 Jan 1764 and then to Jacob Chandler 14 July 1767.
