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Delaware

Deed. On 11 May 1726 John Stout of St. George's Creek, yeoman to Peter Hanson of Red Lyon Hundred. John Stout for £150 granted to Peter Hanson a tract of land called the Liberty bounded by the River Delaware, a branch called Beaver Dam, land John Moll sold to Hance Hanson, dec., land of William Truax containing 150 acres & 30 acres of marsh. Signed John Stout. Delivered in the presence of Christopher Eaton, Cornelius Toby & Francis Land. Recorded 13 May 1726. (H1:20).

Deed. On 9 Apr 1726 John Grant of St. George's Creek, yeoman to Francis Land of Christianna Creek, yeoman. John Grant for £63.11 granted to Francis Land a tract of land at Scott's Run containing 200 acres except 100 acres lately sold to James Atkins to be reserved & another tract [unable to read the description]. Signed John Grant & Mabell Grant. Delivered in the presence of Thomas Jan [unable to read the whole name], Jr., Francis Janvier & Peter Brank. Recorded 12 Aug 1726. (H1:21).

Deed. On Francis Land of Christianna Hundred, yeoman to John Marsh of Thorofare, yeoman. Francis Land for £86.5 granted to John Marsh a tract of land situated on Duck Creek containing 120 acres. Signed Francis Land. Delivered in the presence of Peter Brank & Thomas Potts. Recorded 15 Aug 1726. (H1:22).

Deed. On 18 May 1726 Peter Brank of St. George's Creek, yeoman to Francis Land of Christianna Hundred, yeoman. Peter Brank for £6.16 granted to Francis Land a tract of land at St. George's Creek bounded by the King's Road, land of Lawrence Sheers & the Creek containing 101 acres & 10 acres marsh, it being part of 365 acres granted by Edward Andress to Casperat Harmon on 25 Mar 1676 & from him to Peter Brank. Signed Peter Brank & Anne Brank. Delivered in the presence of Thomas Janvier, Jr., Francis Janvier & John Grant. Recorded 15 Aug 1726. (H1:23).

Deed. On 9 Jan 1725 John Demarett of Appoquinimink Creek, yeoman to Francis Land of Christianna Creek, yeoman. John Desmarest for £50.8 granted to Francis Land a tract of land on the south side of Appoquinimink Creek bounded by the creek & land commonly called New Englandman's Land namely by Ezekiel Osburn containing 400 acres. Signed John Desmarest & Gelah Desmarest. Delivered in the presence of Thomas Bird, Mary Bedford & William Patterson, Sr. Recorded 15 Aug 1726. (H1:24).

Deed. On 16 Nov 1725 Henry Dickson of the County of New Castle, yeoman, & Ruth his wife to William Cox of the County of New Castle, yeoman.
