(continued) Margaret Venables & the father of William, Rebecca & John Venables d 22 Dec 1815, William Venable bro of John Venables d 8 Jul 1823 aged 62 yrs 8 mths 23 days, "Hrsuly?" Venables wife of sol's bro William Venables d 2 Dec 1830, Rebecca Steele d 10 Jun 1829 aged 69 yrs 8 mths 27 days, sol & wife had m in Surry Co NC & sol d 1 Jun 1839 & his wid appl 30 Jul 1839 Stokes Co NC, one William Steele made aff'dt 4 Aug 1839 in Stokes Co NC & stated he m sol's sister Rebecca, wid d 9 Sep 1842 leaving children; Richard, Jesse, Elizabeth, William, Sarah & Mary Venable, Rebecca who m Anderson Pennigan, John Venable & Malcolm Venable who appl 9 Dec 1851 in Stokes Co NC, the sol had orig appl 10 Sep 1833 in Stokes Co NC

VENALL, John P. or John Peter Ahl, Cont Line, S5234, see John Peter Ahl

VENARD, Thomas, VA Line (PA), S16282, sol was b in 1756 in Loudoun Co VA & at age of 20 he moved to Washington Co which was then claimed by VA but was later in PA & later moved to Scott Co KY & in 1790 he moved to Warren Co OH where he appl 30 May 1833

William, VA Line, S14766, sol was b 16 Mar 1759 in Loudoun Co VA & at age of 17 he moved to Washington Co which was then claimed by VA but was later in PA & he lived there at enl & in 1792 he moved to KY, he appl 10 Dec 1832 Harrison Co KY, sol m in 1780 & had children while in service (no names were given), in 1838 sol & his wife about his aged lived in Harrison Co KY & it was stated they had lost 2 sons in the battle of River Raisin on 22 Jan 1812 & some of their children had d since then

VENDRICK, Peter, NC Line, S7791, sol was b 10 Sep 1760 in Craven Co NC & he lived there at enl & he lived there when he appl 17 Oct 1832

VENNER, John, RI Line, S21548, sol lived at Kings Bridge NY at enl, he appl 11 Aug 1832 at North Kingston in Washington Co RI aged 77

VENUS, John, BLW #7906-100-9 Jul 1790 assignee Theodosius Fowler, srv as a Pvt in the NY Line John, NY Line, S26845, on 30 Mar 1821 it was stated sol was an invalid pensioner on the NY rolls John or John Verrus, NY Line, S42595, appl 12 Nov 1822 Queens Co NY aged 68 & stated he had rec'd a pension certificate dated 12 Apr 1821

Michael, NY Line, R10928, appl 21 Feb 1833 Montgomery Co NY, sol was b 10 Jun 1752 in Montgomery Co **VERANO**, Peter, Cont Line (Canada), S18638, sol lived in Lower Canada at enl, he appl 27 Jul 1832 a res of Swanton in Franklin Co VT aged 73

VERBACK, Phillip, NH Line, S14767, BLW #26109-160-55, appl 14 Aug 1832 Orleans Co VT aged 72 & he appl there for BLW on 28 Mar 1855, sol enl at Franconia NH, in 1855 Wm. Verback of Derby VT was a witness

VERBELL, Henry or Henry Wirble, Cont Line, Margaret, W9023, see Henry Wirble

VERBYCK, Ralph, NJ Line, S23468, sol lived in Bergen Co NJ at enl, he appl 29 Nov 1832 Rockland Co NY aged 66 on 25 Feb 1832, sol had srv with his bro Ensign Samuel G. Verbyck & his bro Barnadus (as written) was taken prisoner, on 19 Aug 1842 sol's bro Samuel G. Verbyck made aff'dt in Rockland Co NY aged 81 at which time his bro Ralph Verbyck was still living

Samuel G., NJ Line, S23049, sol lived in Bergen Co NJ at enl, he appl 29 Nvo 1832 Rockland Co NY aged 71, sol's bro Ralph Verbyck made aff'dt in 1832 in Rockland Co NY & had srv in the Rev

William, NJ Line, Rebecca, W8799, sol was b in NJ, he lived in Somerset Co NJ at enl & after the Rev he lived in NJ for many yrs then moved to Mercer Co KY where he d 31 Jan 1824 aged 86, sol had m Rebecca Low 20 Mar 1777 in Somerset Co NJ (where she was born), wid appl 3 Apr 1837 Mercer Co KY aged 79 & in 1851 she had moved to Johnson Co I, in 1837 the oldest child of sol & wid was Dorothy the wid of Lawrence Demott to whom she was m in Feb 1798 & she stated she was b 6 Jan 1778 in Somerset Co NJ & had lived in KY since age of 19 & she stated her parents had 13 children of which 11 were raised to maturity, there were 2 small pages of what appeared to be births of part of sol's & wid's children but was written in Dutch & I could not translate, see N.A. Series M804 roll #2457

● **VERDEN**, James of James Verdin, SC Line, Sarah, W22485, sol appl 15 Oct 1827 Scott Co MO aged 73, sol enl at Charleston SC, in 1827 sol had a wife & 6 married children & lived away from home, on 28 Aug 1838 sol had moved to Montgomery Co IL because nearly all his children lived there, sol m Sarah (--) in Aug 1784 & sol d 18 Jun 1843 & his wid appl 7 Nov 1843 Fayette Co IL aged 77 & a Jacob Verdin was a witness to her application, children's births; Elizabeth b 4 Jul 1785, James b 8 Jul 1787, Jane b 3 Nov 1789, Sarah b 25 Dec 1791, William b 23 Mar 1794, Levi b 1 Apr 1796, Margaret b 13 Jun 1798, Mary b 14 Oct 1800, Charity Cater Verdin b 5 May 1803, Anne Cater Verdin b 25 Sep 1805, sol was b 25 Aug 1756, sol's wid d 30 Sep 1845 leaving children; Elizabeth Davis & Radford Verdin of Montgomery Co IL, William Verdin & Jane Gorden of Christian Co IL, James Verdin & Charity Ciscoe of Shelby Co IL & Levi Verdin of Fayette Co IL who appl 17 Mar 1846 in Fayette Co IL

VERDIER, Benedick, srv as a Lt in the Rev Army (Foreign), BLW #2276-200-29 Aug 1794, no papers

VERGASON, Elijah or Elijah Vargison, CT Line, Margery M.M., W19576, see Elijah Vargison

VERGESON, Daniel, CT Line, Phebe, R10929, sol appl 22 Jun 1818 Bradford Co PA aged 54, in 1820 sol had a wife aged 55 & they had a daughter aged 30 & a crippled son aged 18 living at home, sol had m Phebe (--) in 1784 at Norwich CT & they had 11 children of which the oldest was Anice who was b in 1785 & the youngest was Eunice who m David Russell & she was b in 1807 & the only surviving child in 1844 was Eunice Russell, wid appl 2 Aug 1844 Lycoming Co PA, sol d 27 Jan 1844 in Lycoming Co PA, the daughter Eunice Russell made aff'dt 2 Aug 1844 in Lycoming Co PA aged 36 & was wife of David Russell & on 28 Apr 1853 she signed p.o.a. as heir of her dec'd mother (date of her death not given)

VERGISON, Elijah, BLW #6597-100-9 Sep 1790 assignee James F. Sebor, srv as a Pvt in the CT Line

VERIEUL, Joseph, BLW #7938-100-9 Mar 1791 assignee Sam Smith, srv as a Pvt in the NY Line

VERITY, Samuel, NY Line, R10930, he appl 2 Jun 1835 in Queens Co NY aged 75 & had lived there during the Rev, in 1853 surviving children & heirs were; Hannah Wauza, John, Walter & Richard Verity, Anabella wife of Obediah Verity, Mary wife of Smith Bartow or Barton, Ann wife of Jotham Post, Jacob Verity & Mary Ann wife of William Cloud who were all children of Lawrence Verity (this is as written) also Walter Wauza, Eliza wife of Hiram Valentine & Ester wife of Benjamin Carpenter who were children of Eliza Wauza, the name Wauza may have been Wanza or Wauzar or Wanzar (not clearly written)

VERLIE, Bernard, BLW #13853-100-4 Feb 1790, srv as a Fifer in Hazen's Regt

Francis, BLW #13860-100-4 Feb 1790, srv as a Drummer in Hazen's Regt

Michael, BLW #13852-100-9 Sep 1789 assignee James Reynolds, srv as a Cpl in Hazen's Regt
