Church & Burial Ground of Robert Penland (c.1744-1828)

Quaker Meadows Presbyterian Church is six miles north of Morganton, Burke County, 82 miles from Charlotte, North Carolina. Photos were taken June 23, 2000.

An "1813 Character Reference: **Ruling Elders of the Presbyterian Church at Quaker Meadows** attest to Mrs.



Polly Mira Poor's moral and religious character as a member of their congregation..... 12 Nov 1813, signed: Wm. W. Erwin; **Robert Penland**; Alexander Harrison; ruling elders." Robert Penland was a devoted Christian and was affectionately called "Father" Penland. He died at his home on Canoe Creek, and was buried in a family cemetery on his plantation as was the custom in those days. That cemetery is known as the "Old Robert Alexander Cemetery" by some authorities, and the "Harbison Cemetery" by others. It is said that Robert's tombstone, which could not be found in 1970, has the following inscription: —**Robert Penland**—

Janet Penland-Wisz, daughter of Carl and Wilma Penland, grand-daughter of Ambrose Asbury Penland. (See Family Group Sheet for Ambrose in this quarterly.) Janet was the first member of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution (NSDAR) to be admitted under Lt. William Penland (c.1741-

1815), NSDAR #794714.

Cynthia Kneibel, daughter of Janet, was admitted with her mother with William Penland who married Annis Donnal as her Patriot.

Documents and excerpts from Cynthia's letter will be shown in the November 2000 PHS quarterly.

and future coastal conditions due to global climate change. Currently, he is completing a study entitled, Natural and Human Causes of Coastal Land Loss in Louisiana: The Mississippi River Delta Plain. The goal of this study is to determine the role of geologic and vegetative processes in Louisiana's land loss problem and to

develop a classification that quantifies the types and processes of land loss with emphasis on determining the role of oil and gas activities.

Since 1979, Dr. Penland has published more than 100 scientific papers, received more than 10 science awards conducted more than 30 field trips, and chaired more than 30 scientific meeting sessions in the field

of coastal geomorphology and processes.
