Dennis Garrett

was in Baltimore Co. by 1685 when **Edward Mumford** conveyed to **Garrett** and **Thomas Stone** 100 acres at ^{Long Island} ~~Point~~ ^{Point};

m. **Barbara** (poss. a dau. of Thomas Stone);

she m. as her 2nd husband **John Broad**;

Garrett was murdered by **Captain John Oldton** who hit him on the head with a sword worth 2 shillings on 31 ^{Jul 1691} .

Oldton was tried for murder, sentenced to death, pardoned by the King, and later became Commander of the ^{Baltimore} ~~Rangers~~ ^{Rangers}.

On March 1693 **Thomas Stone** conveyed the tract at Long Island Point to **Barbara Garrett** and her ch. by **Dennis** ^{Garrett}.

Barbara (?) Garrett Broad d. leaving a will 19 Jan. 1732 - 6 Aug 1733, in which she named

her granddau. **Sarah** w. of **Charles Gorsuch**,

son **Thomas Broad**, and his w. **Ann**,

dau. **Frances Haile**,

and granddau **Barbara**;

children of **Dennis and Barbara**:

Johanna m. **John Cole**;

* **Frances** m. **Nicolas Haile**
