William Coale, a Quaker, appeared in what is now A. A. Co. Md. sometime early in the 17th. Century. His second wife, Hannah, had a son named William, who had a son named Thomas. Thomas owned a plantation,,called Coles Harbor, which is known today as Baltimore Harbor. Thomas Coles son, John, b. 1669, d. 1746, married Johannah Garret. b. 1675, d.1710.

The early Colonial Court Records for Northumberland Co. Va. Vol. 2, reveal that Barbary Dennis, b. England, bereaved mother and widow, was administrator of the estates of her son, John, Jr., deceased 7-31-1652 and her husband, John, Sr. deceased 9-4-1652. Sons Richard and Paschall were mentioned in the settlement of

Wm. Stone is thought to have sailed from England in the year of 1621, to Chesapeake Bay, Virginia. He was listed on the passenger list as Maxillan Stone, age 25. Capt William Stone was proclaimed Justice of Accomak in Northumberland Co. Va. In 1640, and commissioned to become Governor of Maryland in 1648. He went to Maryland shortly afterwards, taking around 500 nonconformist with him.

Johannah Garrett was the daughter of Dennis Garrett, b. 1650-51. d. Sept 1, 1891, and Barbara Stone, b. 1652, m. 1667-8. They had another daughter, Frances, b. 1670.

Dennis Garrett was the son of Francis Garrett, b. 1610 and married Mary Dennis, 1649.

Francis Garrett sailed June 6, 1635 from Gravesend, England, for Virginia, on the Thomas and John, at the age of 25. Sir Thomas Girrard Garrett, Knight of Bryan, (Hotton) was his Grandfather and John Garrett was his Father.

Elizabeth Coale, b. Oct 3, 1692, m. Alexander Grant, Jr. had daughter Mary Grant who married Lloyd Ford, Sr. b. 1727, Baltimore Co. Md.

Alexander Grant, Jr. is the son of Alexander Grant.

b. Edinburg, Scotland, and Sarah Hambleton, married Oct. 17, 1709. Family records for thr Hambleton family can be found in St. James Church in Poole, England.

Mary Hambleton is the Daughter of William Hambleton, Poole, England, and Sarah Hambleton
