 Governor of the Mississippi Territory and his
 Successor in office, in the sum of two hundred
 dollars, which payment well and truly to be
 made, we bind ourselves, and each of our Heirs
 Executors and Administrators jointly and severally
 firmly by these presents Sealed with our
 seals and dated the 24th day of February
 in the year 1806 -

The condition of the above obligation is such
 that whereas the above bound Prestwood Smith
 hath this day prayed and obtained a li-
 cence to be joined in marriage to Sarah Brap-
 field of this County Now if there is no
 lawful cause to obstruct the marriage for
 which the licence was granted, then the above
 obligation to be void otherwise to be and re-
 main in full force and virtue.

 assigns firmly by these presents Sealed with my seal, dated
 this 22nd day of September A.D. 1808.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that
 whereas the above bound Reuben Brassfield hath
 this day prayed & obtained a licence for William Sar-
 her to be joined in marriage to Sarah Brassfield of
 the County aforesaid Now if there is no lawful Cause
 to obstruct the marriage for which the licence was gran-
 ted Then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be
 remain in full force and virtue.
