 the claim Interest or remains which they the said Richard Warrinckle & Martha his wife now have
 or may have or hereafter shall have or hereafter shall have in or to the lands given in the Testment of William Moore of the
 County of Worcester to his sons and Daughters to have and to hold the said Interest claim right title and
 demand clear and free from all manner of Incumbrances whatsoever forever and they the said
 Richard Warrinckle and his wife Martha promise and agree to warrant to the said Lewis Cook
 that the said title hereby sold is and shall be supported by them in law against the claim of all
 and every person whatsoever In witness they have hereunto set their hands and created their seals to be
