

Henry Cockerham married Cynthia Chadwich, probably from the Upper Three Runs, Four Mile Branch and Lower Three Runs area in Barnwell County, South Carolina, around 1792. Henry and Cynthia and their four oldest children, Benjamin, Brambley, Mary Elizabeth and John Wesley, apparently accompanied John, Sr. from South Carolina. Henry and Cynthia Cockerham remained in Amite County, Mississippi, long enough to build a house on a rise above the Amite River southwest of Liberty and for Cynthia to give birth to three more children, Sarah, Allen Calvin and Nancy. The family probably moved to Catahoula Parish, Louisiana in 1820, although there is some evidence that Henry had already purchased some property in Catahoula Parish before 1820.
