John MAY, Jr., b. c1784 in NC, d. 1850-60 in Edgefield Co., SC. We are listing John here with a list of his children, but the continuation of his line remains in the file Edgefield Co., SC. He m. Lydia HUSKEY in 1808 in Wake Co., NC (Bond: Darran HALL, witness: William HILL). She was b. 1780-90, d. 1830-40 in Edgefield Co., SC.. He bought from the estate of Spencer WATTS in 1803 in Wake Co., NC, along with Absolam MAY. He bought from the estate sale of Timothy REACH in 1806.

He was on the 1809 Tax List of Wake Co., NC. He was on the 1810 Tax List of Lick Creek District of Wake Co., NC where he paid 1 poll. In 1812, he bought from the estate sale of John RENCHER. He was on the 1811, 1812, & 1813 Tax List in Lick Creek District with 50 acres of land & 1 poll. He was on the 1814 Tax list of Lick Creek District, but that list did not contain any further information. The 1810-20 census records of Wake Co., NC are not extant, & no MAY families appear in the 1830-40 census records.

He was in the 1830-50 census of Edgefield Co., SC. In the 1840 census, he had 1 slave. In 1850, he is a farmer with property valued at \$800. His children were:

- *a. Lemuel MAY, b. 1810 in SC
- *b. Alvin MAY, b. c1821 in SC
- c. (female) MAY, b. 1815-20
- d. (female) MAY, b. 1820-25
- e. Leah MAY, b. c1824 in SC. She was living with her father in the 1850 census of Edgefield Co., SC. She m. John BUTLER in 1858 in Edgefield Co., SC, & was said to have many descendants living there in 1956.
