Item I give and bequeath to my son Green Andrews four Negroes called _____, Tom, Amy, & _____, one feather bed & furniture, eight pounds _____, & six sheep. Item I give and bequeath to my son Green Andrews my _____ tools & shoemaker tools & my little gun. Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Averilla Andrews, to her & her heirs lawfully begotten of her body, four Negroes called Phillis, Minca, Cherry, and Lewis. One feather bed & furniture. Item I give my beloved wife Martha Andrews one Negro called Abagail and four head of cattle. Item I leave the labor of four Negroes called _____, Phillis, Saul, and Cate & the use of our feather bed & furniture during her widowhood.
