



earch so far: Henry Thompson, Sr., "of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, in 1765 pays '5 shillings' to Abraham & Ulah Collet for 700 acres in Rowan County, North Carolina on both sides Mountain Creek of the Catawba River (recorded in Rowan County, North Carolina) but he appears to have died before 20 May 1777:

Rowan Co, NC Deed Book 6 p79-81: [photocopied; abstracted here] Abraham & Ulah Collet to Henry Thompson - 700 ac:

On the 5th day of January 1765 Between Abraham Collet of Ulah/Uliah [clerk records "Uly" when she signs with her mark "x"] his wife of province of North Carolina and County of Rowan of the one part and Henry Thompson of the province of sd and County of Mecklenburg of the other part ... for consideration sum of Five Shillings to them in hand paid by the said Henry Thompson the Receipt is hereby acknowledged have Granted Bargained & Sold by these presents do Bargain & sell unto the sd Henry Thompson a Tract or parcel of Land Situate lying & being in the County of Rowan & province afsd and on both sides of Mountain Creek on the West Side of the Catawba River Beginning at a Spanish Oak about three Quarters of a Mile from the Mouth of sd Creek & about five poles from the Creek Bank on the South side Runs West 80 Chs to a Black Oak then North 87 $^{\circ}$ Chs to a black Saplin then East 80 Chs to two pines then South to the Beginning the same being Granted to Abram Collet By Deed Bearing Date April the fourth 1761 Relation thereunto Being had may be seen at Large appear the same Land containing Seven Hundred acres and all houses and Buildings Gardens Orchards Meadows Waters Water Courses Mines Mineral profits commodities Hereditaments appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining and the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents Issues profits thereof (one fourth part & the half of the Other three fourth part of all Gold Silver Mines accepted/ and also the Estate right title Interest the? Trust property Claim & Demand whatsoever of them the said Abram Collet & Ulah his wife at the sd premises hereby granted and Released & Ever & parcel thereof with their & Every of their appurtenances unto the sd Henry Thompson his Heirs & Assigns ... during term of one full year from Next Ensuing ... paying the rent of one pepper Corn on Lady Day next the same be Lawfully Demanded to the Intent that by Virtue of these presents and force of the Statute for Transferring this [?] into possession the sd Henry Thompson may be in actual possession of the premises & be Enabled to accept & take a Grant of release of for the Reversion & Inheritance thereof to him the said Henry Thompson his heirs & assigns for Ever & C.

October 1765, Indenture Henry Thompson to Samuel Thompson, both of Rowan, for 5 shillings, 180 acres of above land described: on West side Catawba River on both sides of Mountain Creek Beg. At Black Oak on the West side E. 23 Chs to a pine thence South 68 chains to Black Oak, thence W 10 chains to a White Oak thence So 18 chains to Black Oak then W 13 Chains to Black Oak thence to Beginning ... being part of a Tract of Land conveyed to the sd Henry Thompson by Lease & Release the 5th & 6th Days of January 1765, by Abraham Collett and also the Reversion & Reversions, Remainder & Remainders Rents, Issues[?] & Profits of the sd premises

Deed further says on 15 Feb 1778 Henry Thompson and wife Sarah deed to Henry [Jr?] 159 ac on west side of Catawba River and on N side of Mt Cr begin at white oak on n side of Cr and runs N 7 w 209 p to Robt McKessicks line to stake then w 119 poles to the old line then S 186 p along Sam'l Thompsons line to a stake then down the various courses of Cr to beginning, 151 ac being part of tract conveyed by Abraham Collett to Henry Thompson Ser [Sr?] by lease & release 5th & 6th Jan 1765 and said Henry Ser did by will make over sd land to said Wm on 22 nd May 1777. Wit Robert McCusicke, Sam'l Thompson.
