

t sure this Henry is related to me but he appears to have a son, Samuel, who might be my ancestor, so Henry needs to be researched

earch so far: Henry Thompson, Sr., "of Mecklenburg County, North Carolina, in 1765 pays '5 shillings' to Abraham & Ulah Collet for 700 acres in Rowan County, North Carolina on both sides Mountain Creek of the wba River (recorded in Rowan County, North Carolina) but he appears to have died before 20 May 1777:
