commit to the earth to be decently buried. And for those
worldly goods which it hath pleased god to bestow upon me.
I dispose thereof as follows: First I give to my wife Judith
Winterbottom that bed and bedding as it now
stands in the parlor above. And to Mary Chadwick my
younger Daughter the sum of five pounds of good and
lawful money of England. And to Anna Miller my
elder Daughter the sum of twenty shillings. And all
the rest and remaining part of my goods after my just
debts and funeral expenses are payed I give to be
equally divided amongst my wife Judith Winterbottom
and my two sons Simeon Winterbottom and Robert
Winterbottom and Mary Chadwick my younger
Daughter. And I do hereby nominate and appoint my
two sons Simeon Winterbottom and Robert Winterbottom
to be executors of this my last will and Testament
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal the first day of november 1714.
