GARRETT—At Bountiful, June 10, 1887, after a lingering illness, William Garrett born December 26, 1817, at Willenhall, Warwickshire, England; joined the Church October 26th, 1852; was ordained an Elder and subsequently a High Priest, and presided over the Coventry Branch for twelve years; migrated to Utah in 1866; resided at Bountiful for three years then removed to Nephi, Juab Co., and finally returned to Bountiful, where he remained until he died.

He was a faithful Latter-day Saint, was highly respected and besides many friends leaves a wife, nine children and forty-two grandchildren to mourn his death.—COM.
