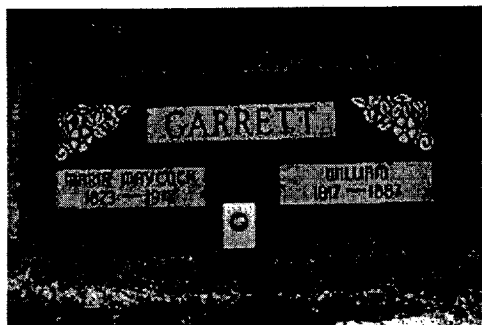
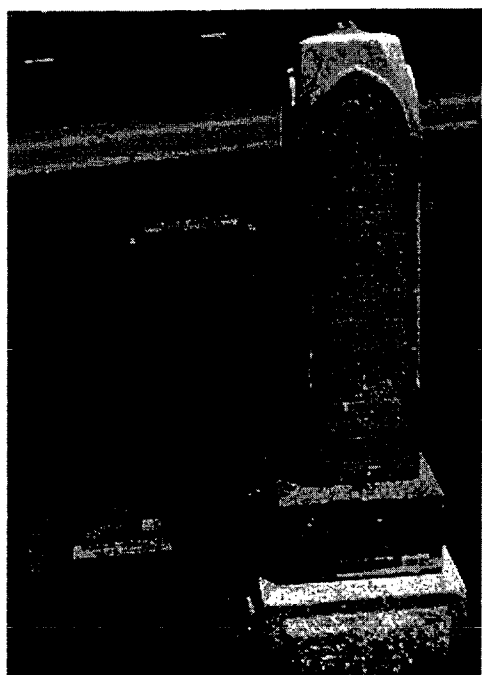

Died of Paralysis.

Friday afternoon, Brother Wm. Garrett, of Bountiful, died from a stroke of paralysis. The attack, we understand, was quite sudden. He was aged 69 years. We are requested to announce that the funeral will be held tomorrow (Sunday) afternoon at 2 o'clock, and that the friends of the family are invited.

William Garrett, Jr. and his wife, Maria Maycock Garrett came to America from England in 1866. They sailed on the ship "Arkwright" departing Liverpool 30 May 1866 and arriving 6 Jul 1866. Along with William and Maria were 6 of their children-- Henry (22), George (18), Lucy M (13), Susannah (9), Mary Jane (6) and Ann P (3). They traveled to the Salt Lake Valley in that same summer but it is not yet known which wagon company they came with.

Four years earlier, the mother of Maria Maycock Garrett, Lucy Gillett Maycock traveled to America on the ship "John J. Boyd". Traveling with Lucy were 3 other children of William and Maria-- James (18), Lizzie or Elizabeth (15) and Hannah (6). They arrived on 23 Apr 1862.
