 But remembered that on the Eleventh day of April in  
 the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and  
 thirty five the will & testament of Benjamin Croy late of  
 said County deceased was duly proven before the clerk  
 of the probate Court of said County and filed for  
 Record which will and testament and the certificate  
 of the date of the proving witnesses endorsed thereon  
 reads in the words and figures following to wit:]

I In the name of god amen I Benjamin Croy of Warren  
 County Indiana do make and publish this my last  
 will and testament in manner and form following  
 (that is to say) first I give and bequeath unto my belov-  
 ed wife Anna Croy all the lands belonging to me in  
 Warren County and all the profits arising from the same  
 likewise all the buildings and other improvements  
 on the said lands likewise all the Cattle Sheep  
 Hogs &c also all the household furniture all the  
 farming utensils & all the Arrears due to me  
 to me Benjamin Croy also my wife or my heirs  
 to dispose of as she shall cause excepting here  
 to be paid to each of my children ten dollars  
 the residue of my estate good chattels of what  
 kind or nature soever I give and bequeath to the  
 same to my said wife Anna Croy to have  
 included. My wife Anna Croy is to satisfy  
 my debts - my wife I hereby appoint as sole  
 executrix of this my last will and testament here  
 by revoking all former wills by me made, I do  
 sign whereof I hereto set my hand and seal  
 this the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1835 Benjamin Croy  
 signed sealed published and delivered by the  
 above named Benjamin Croy to be his last  
 will and testament in presence of us who
