931. **Robert Lowry.** 200 acres. On the North side of Crowders Creek Joining James Lewis's Et & Wt line including two Springs and runs into Mill Creek.
932. **Henry Telling.** --- acres. Joining his open Line of the Land he lives on.
933. **James Foster.** 200 acres. On the waters of Long creek both sides the path that Leads from Hambright to Hoyls Mill.
934. **David Phillips.** 200 acres. On a branch of Kings Creek including James Thompsons improvements and another improvement about a 1/2 a mile above Thomsons.
935. **Peter Summey.** 400 acres. On the north Brances of the south fork of Catauba River Joining Ramsours land where said Summy Lives Warlick Welches & Another of Warlicks Tracts on Clarks creek.
936. **Peter Statler.** 400 acres. On the south side of the South fork Catauba River Joining Potts's and Overwinters Lines including his improvement.
937. **Fred<sup>k</sup>. Propst.** 400 acres. On the North side of the south fork of Catauba River Joining James Willsons and Mathew Willsons Lines and the line of a Tract of Land on Clarks creek.
938. **Moses Moore.** 250 acres. On the waters of Camp creek Joining his own and John Walkers lines on the N<sup>o</sup> side of said Lands.
939. **George Pee.** 200 acres. On a branch of second Broad river making in about about a quarter of a mile from the Cherokee path including a kane Brake.
940. **Gowen Black.** 200 acres. On both sides of Clarks fork of Bullocks' creek Joining McLiwees & Willsons Lines including his own improvement.
- ✓ 941. **William Patterson.** 400 acres. On a south fork of John Welches Branch Joining Warlicks Line and on both sides Fredricks Wisers Branch.
942. **Derick Ramsour.** 150 acres. On the head of Pinceys old field branch Joining his own and Lawcons Lines.
943. **Paul Anthony.** 300 acres. On both sides the Long branch of Clarks creek near and Below Boston Clines Lower line.
- 944. **John Killean.** 200 acres. On both sides of a Branch of Clarks creek Joining the Et side of Mathias Bevers open Line.
945. **John Hawn.** 500 acres. On both sides of Widners creek Joining Crowders Henry Wideners and George Wilpengs lines and including his own improvement.
946. **Abraham Collet.** 300 acres. On Mulls creek a North Branch of Catauba river Joining Mulls wt line.
947. **John Peerson.** 300 acres. On the saddle fork of Silver Creek including the first Large forks about 2 1/2 mile above Canadys and to include a Cabbin begun by said Pearson.
948. **Joseph Dobson.** 300 acres. Both sides Wideners creek Joining Jno Matts uper Line and including a mill place.
949. **Henry Smith.** 300 acres. On a fork of Lyles creek Joining Michael Platners uper Line.
950. **William Knox.** 200 acres. On both sides Smithers creek Joining Stovel Kizers uper Line.
951. **Henry Reader.** 200 acres. On a branch of Clarks creek Joining William Bests nichs Fry's and Lockarts.
952. **Boston Cline.** 300 acres. On the South Branches of Liles's creek Joining Henry Popes and Jacob Wisements lines.
953. **Simon Jonas.** 150 acres. On both sides the Long branch a North run of Lyles's creek.
954. **Nicholas Frye.** 250 acres. On the waters of the south fork of Jacobs River on the south side of the indian path about 3 miles from Shuffords including some meadows.
955. **George Pope and Beston Cline.** 200 acres. On Both sides the Long Branch on the North side Lyles creek Joining Simon Jonas's entry and including some indian old fields.
956. **Peter Club.** 100 acres. On a branch of Leepers creek that runs in between Peter Club and Caster Clubs Joining his own Line.
957. **Michael Ingle.** 200 acres. On both sides Leeper creek including the mouth of Lick run and his own improvement.
- ✓ 958. **Abraham Erehart.** 150 acres. On the waters of Killions creek Join<sup>g</sup> his own and Adam Dicks s<sup>o</sup> side Lines.
