Edward Alvin Crow's parents were Abial Crow (b. March 9, 1801 d. September 8, 1879 Windsorville, CT) and Rhoda (maiden name unknown)(b. abt. 1802 d. May 20, 1877 Windsorville, CT). About the Crow name: it derives from our ancestral home town of Auchencraw, Scotland. Auchencraw is a small town approx. 50 miles southeast of Edinburgh and currently one of the principal businesses in the town is the Crow Inn, which functions as the town pub as well as an Inn. The Crow family has been in America since the early days of the colonies. Robert Crow emigrated from Scotland in the 1640s and was known to be living in Newport, RI in 1651. I am descended from him. There was a 2nd emigration in 1790 (2 brothers William & John Crow who settled in New York City) and another in 1873 when Alexander Crow came over and settled in the area of Los Angeles, CA.

Hi Cathy,

I have a Edward Alvin Craw and a Henry Craw (both born about 1823) in my database - - but have no specific information connecting them. Both Edward's and Henry's lines stop one generation back. There is some speculation among several Craw genealogists that Jonathon Craw, Jr. (b. 1749 Enfield, CT d. between 1810 & 1820 in Onondaga County, NY) had several children that we don't know about and that the fathers of Edward and Henry may be sons of Jonathon - - but that speculation has never been confirmed. If this speculation is correct, that would make Edward and Henry 1st cousins. (I can provide the information about Edward and Henry's fathers if you are interested in that.)

BTW: I have visited the Pioneer Cemetery in San Bernardino, CA and have seen the grave sites of Edward and Martha Craw.
