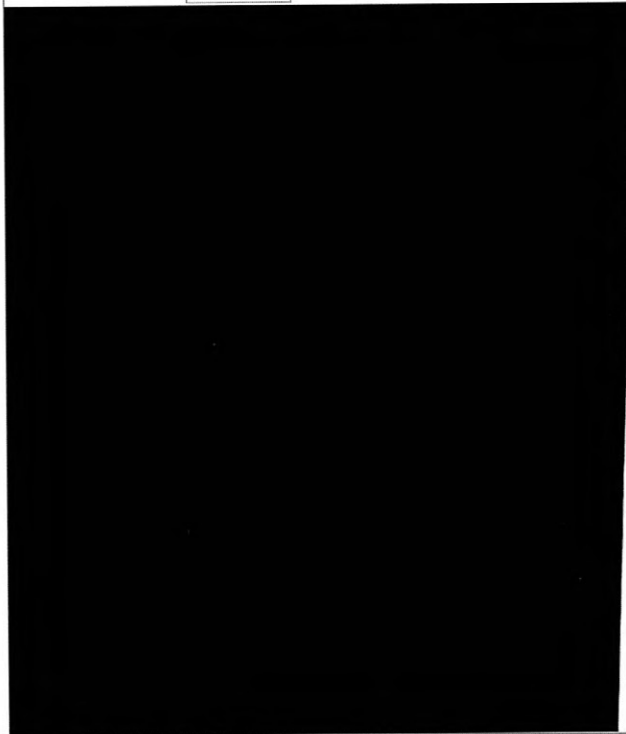

here and was harassed by Tories until he broke his parole and served with General Sumner at Black Stock on the Tyger river. He was also with General Green at the battle of the Cow Pens and at Kings Mountain under General Morgan.

See the attached hand written affidavit made by Lieutenant Eird on May 12, 1836, before Justice of the Peace, Stephen Johnson, at the Union District Court House, South Carolina and affidavits made by Major Joseph McJunkin and Major Thos. Young, corroborating his statements as to his Revolutionary War service.

A typed copy of the handwritten document is included for ready reference. The document was received from the National Archivist, General Services Administration, Washington, D.C.
