

Short History of John Killian (10:8)


JOHN KILLIAN WAS MARRIED TO ANN ELIZABETH FULBRIGHT, BORN 25 MAY 1744, MOTHER OF CHILDREN. SHE WAS THE DAUGHTER OF JOHN WILLIAM FULBRIGHT AND CHRISTINA HALSTEAD SHOOK.


ANN ELIZABETH FULBRIGHT MARRIED FIRST TO MICHAEL ZIMMERMAN. MICHAEL AND ELIZABETH ZIMMERMAN WERE BROTHER AND SISTER, THE CHILDREN OF MICHAEL ZIMMERMAN, SR. ELIZABETH ZIMMERMAN WAS MARRIED TO JOHN YOUNT, NOT JOHN KILLIAN, AND SHE HAD 2 CHILDREN, JOHN GEORGE YOUNT AND JACOB A YOUNT.

!MARRIAGE: see source note with marriage which suggests their marriage was in mid 1760s. This makes her a very young widow, but it is possible, and she could have a first and even second child born by 1760 i.e. the cited source gives her a birth of ca 1744. This would make her older than one might expect for John, born 1726.

!CHILDREN: Note of Feb 2000. I am starting to doubt the dates of birth for the children. Considering only his age, it seems that having a first child in 1758 at age 32 is a little late. But note also that his son, Philip, did not have children until he was 30 or even older if we think this John had his children at a younger age. And for that matter I, George W. Killian did not have children until I was 31, and my own Killian grandfather had a first child when he was past 30. Perhaps it runs in the family. My own son had his first child when he was 35.

!INFO-IN: note copied from a Pedigree chart made by Cletus Hugo KILLIAN, dated 1 Jan 1954. ".. he is probably buried on his own land near his father's farm. John was the blacksmith of the "Dutch Settlement."
