1790 Lincoln Co NC census - 4 m > 16, 1m < 16, 3f. 1 m < 16 probably John Jonas, Mary's son. #01 54.

1747 - enlisted with Colonial forces at time of Spanish Alarm 1747/48.

1749 Apr 13 - Colonial Council held in New Bern, granted 1000 acres in Anson County, NC on Leeper's creek next to Leonard (part is now Lincoln County) to John Killian. Deed Abstracts of Tryon, Lincoln, & Rutherford Counties, NC.

1749 Sep 30 - 157 acres granted to John Killion South side Catawba in Mecklenburg County, N C p 78. 1754 Jan 2 John and wife, Ann, sold the 157 acres to Jacob Brown.

1759 Sep 13 - 250 acres granted to John Killian south side Catawba river on Coburn's Creek. Page 89.

1759 Sep 30 - 1000 acres granted to John Kilion south side Catawba river. Page 43.

1766 - bought 200 acres on Clark's Creek in Rowan Co, NC, near present day Newton in Catawba County from Mathias Beaver, joined 293 acres owned by father Andreas.

Will dated 1795.

## Notes for ANNA ELIZABETH CARPENTER:

Some have maiden name Carpenter others Vollbrecht or Fulbright

Will dated 1 Mar 1802 - mentions son Michael Zimmerman, son-in-law David Smith, Jacob, Marellis, who married Jacob Yount, John, Philip, Mary Suttlemyre, Abraham, and Sarah, who married Jacob Dietz.

Also some have death 1802 and 1820? Believed died in 1820 aged 87 years 11 months, as per Gene Killian.
