

## Elizabeth Zimmerman Killian *Surname: Zimmerman*

- *Given Name:* Elizabeth/Ann Elizabeth
- *Birth:* ABT 1730 in Of Palatinate, Germany
- *Death:* 1 Mar 1802 in Lincoln, North Carolina, United States

NAME: She is believed to have been the *widow* Zimmerman. Her maiden name may have been Carpenter. But see also the "source listed with respect to her which suggests her maiden name may have been FULBRIGHT. There is also a suggestion that her name may have been *Ann Elizabeth*.

!MISC: The following information furnished by Gene Killian, with the following comment: "There may be some clues in the following that could eventually lead to a positive identification of Ann Elizabeth (Unknown) (Zimmerman) Killian's family, and her maiden name."

Hans Michael Zimmerman (b 1715 d 1741 PA) came to America on the Ship "William & Sarah" in 1727. He was recorded as a member of Goshenhoppen Reformed Church, who married Anna Elizabeth Dodderer [Dodder?] (b 1709 PA). She married 2nd Jacob Koerr [Kurt?] and had six children by him. Note: Old Goshenhoppen Church is near present Norristown and Pottstown, PA

Among their children:

1) Johannes Michael Zimmerman (Baptized 1733, probably died by 1756-57 in PA) married Ann Elizabeth (Unknown) b 1732 d 1820 Lincoln Co. NC. Their children were Michael and Catherina Zimmerman, later of Lincoln Co, NC (**From Ann Elizabeth (Unknown) (Zimmerman) Killian's Will.**)

2) Anna Elizabeth Zimmerman who married Johannes Jundt (John Yount) and moved from PA to Lincoln Co, NC.

Among their children were: Jacob A Yount who married Marellis Killian [RIN 46], a daughter of Ann Elizabeth (Unknown) [widow of Johannes Michael Zimmerman], and John Killian (Sr) son of Andreas [RIN 51]. Who brought the young widow (age 27), Ann Elizabeth (Unknown) Zimmerman and her two children, Catherina and Michael, from PA to NC, where she married John [RIN 42] Killian (Sr) about 1759? Perhaps, her sister-in-law's family, John and Anna Elizabeth (Zimmerman) Yount. Of course, it is also quite possible that John Killian (Sr) made a trip to PA and married her there, since no one seems to have found and published a record of their marriage in NC.

!CHILDREN: She is believed to have had a son, Michael, by her first husband.

!DEATH: Derick S HARTSHOIRN III (& WIFE) RIN 36553 said she died 1 Mar 1802. I would like to get more info (Feb 2000)
