North Manchester News Journal Jan. 20, 1910:

Ray Phillips, whose sickness was of long duration and was frequently mentioned, died at the home of his parents, Thursday. The cause of his death was intestinal poisoning and Bright's disease. Funeral took place Saturday afternoon from the Methodist church conducted by Rev. D. Hidy assisted by Rev. P.B. Fitzwater. A large congregation was present. Burial was made in Oak Lawn cemetery.

Ray Phillips, was the son of Lyman and Susan A. Phillips and was born near Liberty Mills, June 12, 1891. Died January 13, 1910, aged eighteen years, seven months and one day. Deceased was an exemplary young man and passed into the great beyond leaving no cloud or shadow on the home, having at no time in his short life caused his parents worry or sorrow for any act of his. He was a favorite with all his associates, a straight forward, upright and honest boy loved by all who knew him. Deceased graduated from the high school of this city in the class of 1909 and during his school life carried the reputation of being a thorough and conscientious student, being a favorite with his teachers and classmates. His untimely death has caused a great sorrow to his parents and friends and they have the sympathy of many friends.

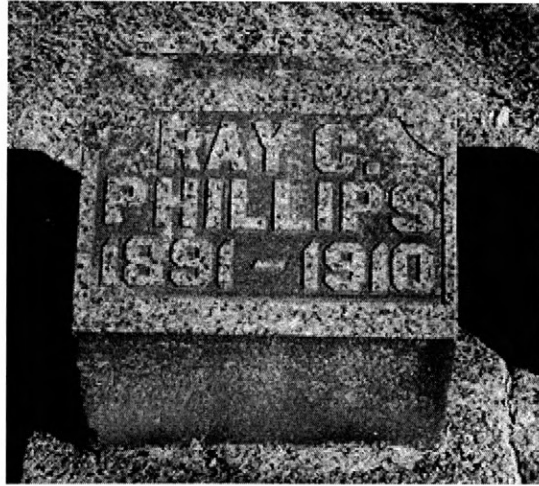
