

Stephen B. Neyman

He was the son of Casper & Rosana (Miller) Neyman.

He was educated in common schools of the day and took over his father's milling business, in Mercer County, at the age of eighteen. After one year he went to Decatur, Adams County, Indiana. Here he worked as a millwright.

Moving on again he went to Liberty Mills, Wabash County, where he learned the trade of cabinet making. He went to Iowa for a time but returned to Wabash County where he became engaged in farming.

He married Caroline Prugh, 7 Nov 1855, Indiana. In 1867 he moved his family to Pleasant Hill, Cass County, Missouri.

He spent the rest of his life as an undertaker and wood worker. Advertisement at right from the PLEASANT HILL WEEKLY LEADER, 23 June 1871.
