Deceased was born October 18, 1804, in Pitsford, Rutland Co, Vermont; shared in the persecution and driving of the Saints from the States; lived, as he died, rejoicing in the Gospel of the Son of God; in his last sickness he rejoiced exceedingly that he had lived to see the day when the organization of the Order of Enoch was commenced on the earth, and that he had the privilege, which he gladly embraced, of having his property appraised in it, after which he felt willing to depart, charging his family to live steadfast in the faith of the Gospel; he has left a wife, four children and many grandchildren. - Com.
