Will of Nathaniel Harriott, proved Bellefontaine, Logan County, Ohio, 24 November 1841: (1) son Samuel Harriott one bay mare (2) son Smith Harriott 40 acres of land adjoining the land which Smith Harriott holds title for, being in the county of Allen, Ohio (3) son James Harriott 80 acres of land in Mercer County, Ohio subject to sale at Lima, Ohio; plus one cow and calf (4) daughter Maria Harriott one cow and calf, one yearling colt and all the household furniture (5) daughter Caroline Harriott sum of \$50 (6) son Nathaniel 80 acres of land in the county of Mercer in Ohio (Auglaize County, where Nathaniel was found in 1850 and 1860 was formed from Mercer County in 1848) adjoining above mentioned land, plus one horse, two cows, and calves, one horse wagon, lot of books (7) daughter Hannah Thompson sum of \$37 which Thomas Thompson has in hand (8) Smith Harriott and Nathaniel Harriott appointed executors.
