

In the Name of God Amen the 19th Day of April Anno Domini 1763. I Joshua Case of Simsbury in the County of Hartford and Colony of Connecticut, being grown aged and Labouring under many Bodily Infirmities, but of perfect mind and Memory, Thanks be given unto God, therefor, and Calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die do make ordain and appoint this my last will and Testament, viz: Principally and first of all I recommend my Soul into the hands of God who have it and my Body to the Earth to be Buried in a Decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Exor hereafter Named; and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I give and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form, after just Debts such as are due and funeral Charges are paid. viz:

In primis I give and Bequeath unto my beloved Wife Amoy one third part of all my Movable or personal Estate where and what soever, for her use and improvement and Dispose During her Natural Life, and then to be Equally Divided among my Three Daughters hereafter Named; also I give unto her the use and improvement of the Manse or Dwelling House where I now Dwell with Two Acres of Land thereto Adjoining During the full Term of her Natural Life, also the use and improvement of Six Acres of Mowing Land Lying at a southerly End of my Mowing pasture next to the highway a little westward of where my house stood that was lately burned down; also for use and improvement of One Acre of Orcharding on the northerly Side of the highway next to the highway near my Barn all which Improvements to be and remain for the use of my said beloved wife During the full Term of her Natural Life.

Remaining by Deeds of Gift given to my Two Sons Reuben & Joshua full of their portions of my Estate. I now give and Bequeath unto my Three Daughters viz: Elisabeth, Naomi, and Rebekah, all my Personal, or Movable Estate where and what soever to be Equally Divided between and amongst them, to be and remain to them their heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby utterly Revoke, and Disannul all and every other Will and Testament before by me made, and made before by me named: holding this and no other to be my last will and Testament, and I do hereby ordain and appoint my aforesaid Son Reuben Case to be Executor of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, and Seal the day and Date above written.
