GRIM REAPER CLAIMED TOLL OF 148 IN JOHNSTOWN DURING YEAR 1917

Four Venerable Residents Had Passed Within Shadow of the Century Mark—Largest Number of Deaths in January and September, While August Holds Low Record.

The Grim Reaper claimed a toll of 148 lives in Johnstown during the year 1917, now drawing to a close, according to the records in the office of City Clerk Grover E. Yerdon, who is also city registrar of vital statistics. The greatest number of deaths occurred during the months of January and September, when 18 persons passed
