

This Indenture made the twenty-fifth day of February in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and twelve between Samuel Chamberlain of the town of  
Stockbridge county and state of New Hampshire of the one part and Edward Black of Springfield  
said township Elizur's county and state aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the  
said Samuel Chamberlain for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty  
dollars money of the United States to him in hand given and truly paid or being nevertheless  
paid about before the concluding and delivery hereof the receipt whereof he doth  
hereby acknowledge say granted bargained sold alined enfeoffed released and  
consigned unto the said Edward Black all the following lots of ground numbered  
in the general draft of the town of Hersey as follows number one hundred and  
thirty seven and one hundred and thirty eight counted and described as follows to wit  
beginning at a post thence forth two degrees West by Turkey alley due hundred and  
thirty feet thence South eighteenth degrees West by her alley one hundred and twenty  
feet thence South ten degrees East by lot 114129 two hundred and twenty feet and thence

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forty eight degrees East by Butter street one hundred and twenty feet to the place of beginning, and lot number one hundred and thirteen bounded and described as follows to wit, beginning at a post thence North two degrees West by Turkey alley one hundred and twenty feet, thence South eighty-eight degrees West by Market street fifty feet, thence South two degrees East by lot No 116 one hundred and twenty feet and thence North eighty-eight degrees East by rear alleys forty feet to the place of beginning, & being the same lots or pieces of ground which Adam Chambers, John Leach and Robert Ryer commissioners of the said county of Mercer by their deeds bearing date the third day of October anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and eight granted and conveyed the same unto the said Samuel Chambers party hereto his heirs and assigns forever. Together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, rights, liberties, advantages, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said described three lots of ground hereditaments and privileges aforesaid or mentioned or intended to be with the appurtenances unto the said Adam Black his heirs and assigns to the sole proper uses benefit and behoof of him the said Adam Black his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Samuel Chambers for himself and his heirs doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Adam Black his heirs and assigns for these presents that he the said Samuel Chambers and his heirs the aforesaid three lots of ground heretofore granted with the appurtenances unto the said Adam Black his heirs and assigns, against him the said Samuel Chambers and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same shall and will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said Adam Black his heirs and assigns forever. This Indenture made the nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Adam Black of Springfield Township Mercer County and State of Pennsylvania and Mary his wife of the one part and John Chambers of the Borough of Elizabethtown in said county of the other part witnesseth that the said Adam Black for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars money of the United States to him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Chambers at and before the executing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and himself acquit and forever discharge the said John Chambers his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns by these presents hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, released, remised, confirmed and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said John Chambers all the following described lots in the Borough of Elizabethtown land adjacent to west lots in the Borough numbers one hundred and four hundred and one hundred and fifteen one hundred and thirteen one hundred and thirty-five and one hundred and thirty-eight and ten acres of land on donation tract #4575, 32 district laid off in lots by John Morrison and numbered Street. Together with all and singular the buildings, improvements, rights, liberties, privileges, advantages

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undertakings and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reverting and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To have and to hold the said above-mentioned and described lots, & ~~or~~<sup>and</sup> hereditaments and premises hereby granted, as mentioned or intended to be with the appurtenances unto the said John Chambers his heirs and assigns forever; in special trust and confidence nevertheless and to and for the only proper use and behoof of the heirs of the said John Chambers by his wife Bessie daughter of said Adam Black and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever and thence heretofore to the contrary notwithstanding. And the said Adam Black for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators doth covenant, promise and grant to and with the said John Chambers his heirs and assigns by these presents that he the said Adam Black and his heirs the said tract of land and lots aforesaid and premises hereby granted or mentioned or intended to be of the appurtenances unto the said John Chambers (in trust for his children by his wife Bessie his heirs and assigns forever) his heirs and assigns against whom the said Adam Black and his heirs and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof by, from or under him them or any of them shall and will warrant and forever defend under the considerations aforesaid to this present.
