

John W. W. W. made this 4 day of Nov: 1796 & 20th year of the Independence of the United States between Evans Shelby of the County of Mecklenburg & State of Carolina of the one part & Thomas Alexander of the other part Witnesseth that the said Evans Shelby for & in consideration of the sum of 300 pounds currency of S. State to him in hand paid the receipt of which by Act of the 20th Decemr 1794 grant in full & complete satisfaction the said Thomas Alexander his heirs & assigns forever do hereby grant a part of land lying in said County & State on both sides of the said Creek beginning at a bushy & small S. line then N. 40th 40th p. to a S. line then S. 45th N. 80th p. to a small S. O. then South 134th p. to a large bush on the bank of S. Creek then across the middle of the Channel to the mouth of a small branch then S. 22th N. 13th h. to a S. O. then S. 59th N. 61th p. to a small large S. O. on the N. line then with S. line S. 71th E. 101th p. to a S. O. his corner on the Alexander line then with S. line S. 32th E. 58th p. to a S. O. of which his corner then with his other line S. 77th E. 20th p. to a small S. O. his other corner then with another line of his N. 32th E. 30th p. to a large bush another corner of his then with another line of his S. 77th E. 80th p. to a S. O. on S. line an old corner then with a old line N. 21th E. 105th p. to a line in old corner then to the beginning by estimation containing 315 acres being part of 2 parts of land then conveyed from Henry E. W. called to Benjamin Alexander dated as of record the other by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of S. State 17th Decemr 1768 then conveyed from S. State to Thomas Alexander his son by said Act of Decemr 1787. To have & to hold the said 315 acres of land & all & every the appurtenances unto the said Thomas Alexander his heirs & assigns forever with all the common & usual rights & profits thereof and with full power unto the said Thomas Alexander his heirs & assigns forever that he his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & defend the said land & premises free from all legal claims of all & every person whatsoever unto the said Thomas Alexander his heirs & assigns forever In Witness whereof the said Evans Shelby hath hereunto set his hand & seal this day & year first above written.
